THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- SEC. 1242. (1) NOT LATER THAN OCTOBER 1, 2018, THE BOARD OF A

 SCHOOL DISTRICT OR BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF A PUBLIC SCHOOL ACADEMY

 SHALL SUBMIT A REPORT TO THE DEPARTMENT THAT INCLUDES BOTH OF THE
