

HOUSE BILL No. 6370

September 25, 2018, Introduced by Rep. Vaupel and referred to the Committee on Health Policy.

A bill to amend 1974 PA 258, entitled
"Mental health code,"
(MCL 330.1001 to 330.2106) by adding section 111.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 **SEC. 111. (1) THE DEPARTMENT, IN CONSULTATION WITH COMMUNITY**
2 **MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES BOARDS, BEHAVIORAL HEALTH AUTHORITIES, STATE**
3 **HOSPITALS AND TRAINING CENTERS, INDIVIDUALS RECEIVING SERVICES,**
4 **FAMILIES OF INDIVIDUALS RECEIVING SERVICES, ADVOCACY ORGANIZATIONS,**
5 **AND OTHER INTERESTED PARTIES, SHALL DEVELOP AND UPDATE BIENNIALY A**
6 **6-YEAR COMPREHENSIVE STATE PLAN FOR BEHAVIORAL HEALTH AND**
7 **DEVELOPMENTAL SERVICES.**

8 **(2) THE COMPREHENSIVE STATE PLAN SHALL IDENTIFY THE NEEDS OF**
9 **AND THE RESOURCE REQUIREMENTS FOR PROVIDING SERVICES AND SUPPORTS**
10 **TO INDIVIDUALS WITH MENTAL ILLNESS, DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES, OR**

1 SUBSTANCE USE DISORDER IN THIS STATE AND SHALL PROPOSE STRATEGIES
2 TO ADDRESS THESE NEEDS. THE COMPREHENSIVE STATE PLAN SHALL BE USED
3 IN THE DEVELOPMENT OF THE DEPARTMENT'S ANNUAL BUDGET PROCESS.

4 (3) NOT LATER THAN 180 DAYS AFTER THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THE
5 AMENDATORY ACT THAT ADDED THIS SECTION, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL
6 PRESENT THE 6-YEAR COMPREHENSIVE STATE PLAN DEVELOPED UNDER
7 SUBSECTION (1) TO THE LEGISLATURE.

8 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
9 after the date it is enacted into law.
