

HOUSE BILL No. 6391

September 26, 2018, Introduced by Reps. Chang, Howrylak and Kosowski and referred to the Committee on Law and Justice.

A bill to amend 1975 PA 238, entitled
"Child protection law,"
(MCL 722.621 to 722.638) by adding section 14a.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 SEC. 14A. IF THE DEPARTMENT RECEIVES INFORMATION THAT A CHILD
2 OR A PERSON RESPONSIBLE FOR THE CHILD'S HEALTH OR WELFARE HAS BEEN
3 THE VICTIM OF AN ASSAULTIVE CRIME, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL PROVIDE THE
4 CHILD AND THE PERSON RESPONSIBLE FOR THE CHILD'S HEALTH OR WELFARE
5 INFORMATION ORALLY AND IN WRITING REGARDING THE LOCATION OF AND
6 SERVICES OFFERED BY CRIME SURVIVOR TRAUMA RECOVERY CENTERS
7 ESTABLISHED UNDER THE MICHIGAN CRIME SURVIVOR TRAUMA RECOVERY
8 CENTER ACT. AS USED IN THIS SECTION, "ASSAULTIVE CRIME" MEANS THAT
9 TERM AS DEFINED IN SECTION 9A OF CHAPTER X OF THE CODE OF CRIMINAL
10 PROCEDURE, 1927 PA 175, MCL 770.9A.

1 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
2 after the date it is enacted into law.

3 Enacting section 2. This amendatory act does not take effect
4 unless Senate Bill No.____ or House Bill No. 6388 (request no.
5 06335'18) of the 99th Legislature is enacted into law.
