## **SENATE BILL No. 351**

May 2, 2017, Introduced by Senator COLBECK and referred to the Committee on Government Operations.

A bill to amend 2011 PA 256, entitled "Michigan fireworks safety act,"

by amending section 7 (MCL 28.457), as amended by 2013 PA 65.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 7. (1) Except as provided in this act, a local unit of
- 2 government shall not enact or enforce an ordinance, code, or
- 3 regulation pertaining to or in any manner regulating the sale,
- 4 display, storage, transportation, or distribution of fireworks
- 5 regulated under this act.
- (2) A local unit of government may enact an ordinance
- 7 regulating the ignition, discharge, and use of consumer fireworks,
- 8 including, but not limited to, an ordinance prescribing the hours
- 9 of the day or night during which a person may ignite, discharge, or

- 1 use consumer fireworks. If a local unit of government enacts an
- 2 ordinance under this subsection, the ordinance shall MUST not
- 3 regulate the ignition, discharge, or use of consumer fireworks on
- 4 the day preceding, the day of, or the day after a national holiday
- 5 except as follows: THE FOURTH OF JULY.
- 6 (a) A local unit of government with a population of 50,000 or
- 7 more or a local unit of government located in a county with a
- 8 population of 750,000 or more may regulate the ignition, discharge,
- 9 or use of consumer fireworks between the hours of 12 midnight and 8
- 10 a.m. or between the hours of 1 a.m. and 8 a.m. on New Year's day.
- 11 (b) A local unit of government with a population of less than
- 12 50,000 located in a county with a population of less than 750,000
- 13 may regulate the ignition, discharge, or use of consumer fireworks
- 14 between the hours of 1 a.m. and 8 a.m.
- 15 (3) An ordinance under subsection (2) shall MUST only impose a
- 16 civil fine of not more than \$500.00 for each violation of the
- 17 ordinance and no other fine or sanction.
- 18 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
- 19 after the date it is enacted into law.
