

SENATE BILL No. 456

June 14, 2017, Introduced by Senator KNEZEK and referred to the Committee on Transportation.

A bill to amend 1949 PA 300, entitled "Michigan vehicle code," by amending section 676b (MCL 257.676b).

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 676b. (1) A person, without authority, shall not block,
2 obstruct, impede, or otherwise interfere with the normal flow of
3 vehicular or pedestrian traffic upon a public street or highway in
4 this state, by means of a barricade, object, or device, or with his
5 or her person. This section ~~shall~~**DOES** not apply to persons
6 maintaining, rearranging, or constructing public utility facilities
7 in or adjacent to a street or highway.

8 (2) **A COUNTY, TOWNSHIP, CITY, OR VILLAGE MAY PERMIT A PERSON**
9 **WHO IS SOLICITING CONTRIBUTIONS ON BEHALF OF A CHARITABLE**
10 **ORGANIZATION TO SOLICIT CONTRIBUTIONS WHILE STANDING IN THE**
11 **IMPROVED PORTION OF A ROADWAY WITHIN THE JURISDICTION OF THAT**

1 COUNTY, TOWNSHIP, CITY, OR VILLAGE.

2 (3) ~~(2)~~—A person who violates this section is responsible for
3 a civil infraction.

4 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
5 after the date it is enacted into law.
