## **SENATE BILL No. 470**

June 21, 2017, Introduced by Senators CONYERS, HERTEL, GREGORY and HOOD and referred to the Committee on Commerce.

A bill to amend 2006 PA 491, entitled "Michigan works one-stop service center system act," by amending section 13 (MCL 408.123).

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 13. A local workforce development board shall do all of the following in cooperation with the chief elected officials in the Michigan works area:
  - (a) Develop and submit to the governor a plan for coordinating local workforce development services for employers and job seekers in the area. The plan shall—MUST provide for access to designated core services with no fees or charges and shall—MUST provide services beyond the core services based on eligibility criteria.
  - (b) Award competitive grants or contracts to eligible providers.
    - (c) Develop a budget.
