## **SENATE BILL No. 495**

June 28, 2017, Introduced by Senator CASPERSON and referred to the Committee on Government Operations.

A bill to amend 1986 PA 268, entitled "Legislative council act,"

(MCL 4.1101 to 4.1901) by amending the title and by adding chapter 7C.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 TITLE

An act to create the legislative council; to prescribe its membership, powers, and duties; to create a legislative service bureau to provide staff services to the legislature and the council; to provide for operation of legislative parking facilities; to create funds; to provide for the expenditure of appropriated funds by legislative council agencies; to authorize the sale of access to certain computerized data bases; to establish fees; to create the Michigan commission on uniform state laws; to

- 1 create a law revision commission; to create a senate fiscal agency
- 2 and a house fiscal agency; to create a Michigan capitol committee;
- 3 to create a commission on intergovernmental relations; LEGISLATIVE
- 4 BUDGET AGENCY; to prescribe the powers and duties of certain state
- 5 agencies and departments; to repeal certain acts and parts of acts;
- 6 and to repeal certain parts of this act on specific dates.
- 7 CHAPTER 7C
- 8 LEGISLATIVE BUDGET AGENCY
- 9 SEC. 791. AS USED IN THIS CHAPTER:
- 10 (A) "FISCAL BILL" MEANS A BILL THAT WOULD REQUIRE THIS STATE
- 11 OR LOCAL UNITS OF GOVERNMENT TO PROVIDE ACTIVITIES AND SERVICES
- 12 THAT CREATE MORE THAN A DE MINIMUS NEW COST OR INCREASED COST TO
- 13 THIS STATE OR LOCAL UNITS OF GOVERNMENT. THE LEGISLATIVE BUDGET
- 14 AGENCY AND THE CHAIRPERSON OF THE COMMITTEE TO WHICH A BILL IS
- 15 REFERRED MAY DESIGNATE A BILL AS A FISCAL BILL.
- 16 (B) "FISCAL NOTE" MEANS A WRITTEN ESTIMATE OF THE COSTS,
- 17 SAVINGS, REVENUE GAIN, OR REVENUE LOSS THAT MAY RESULT FROM THE
- 18 IMPLEMENTATION OF A FISCAL BILL.
- 19 (C) "LOCAL UNIT OF GOVERNMENT" MEANS A POLITICAL SUBDIVISION
- 20 OF THIS STATE.
- 21 (D) "PROPOSAL" MEANS A PLAN OR AN ACTIVITY THAT IS UNDER
- 22 CONSIDERATION BY A MEMBER OF THE LEGISLATURE. A PROPOSAL SHALL NOT
- 23 BE CONSIDERED PUBLISHED UNTIL IT IS AUTHORIZED FOR RELEASE BY THE
- 24 MEMBER OF THE LEGISLATURE REQUESTING THE PREPARATION OF THE
- 25 PROPOSAL.
- 26 (E) "SPECIAL REPORT" MEANS A REPORT THAT IS REQUESTED BY A
- 27 MEMBER OF THE LEGISLATURE TO BE PREPARED BY THE LEGISLATIVE BUDGET

- 1 AGENCY. A SPECIAL REPORT SHALL NOT BE CONSIDERED PUBLISHED UNTIL IT
- 2 IS AUTHORIZED FOR RELEASE BY THE MEMBER REQUESTING THE REPORT.
- 3 SEC. 792. (1) THE LEGISLATIVE BUDGET AGENCY IS CREATED AS A
- 4 NONPARTISAN AGENCY TO BE OF SERVICE TO ALL MEMBERS OF THE
- 5 LEGISLATURE. THE LEGISLATIVE BUDGET AGENCY SHALL MONITOR INTRODUCED
- 6 BILLS AND PREPARE FISCAL NOTES AS PROVIDED IN SECTION 793 AND SHALL
- 7 PREPARE AN ANNUAL FINANCIAL REPORT AS PROVIDED IN SECTION 794.
- 8 (2) THE LEGISLATIVE BUDGET AGENCY SHALL BE GOVERNED BY A
- 9 GOVERNING BOARD OF 6 MEMBERS OF THE LEGISLATURE. THE MEMBERS OF THE
- 10 GOVERNING BOARD ARE AS FOLLOWS:
- 11 (A) THE SENATE MAJORITY LEADER.
- 12 (B) THE SENATE MINORITY LEADER.
- 13 (C) THE CHAIRPERSON OF THE SENATE APPROPRIATIONS COMMITTEE.
- 14 (D) THE SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES.
- 15 (E) THE HOUSE MINORITY LEADER.
- 16 (F) THE CHAIRPERSON OF THE HOUSE APPROPRIATIONS COMMITTEE.
- 17 (3) THE MEMBERS OF THE GOVERNING BOARD OF THE LEGISLATIVE
- 18 BUDGET AGENCY SHALL MEET QUARTERLY. IN ADDITION TO THE QUARTERLY
- 19 MEETINGS, THE GOVERNING COMMITTEE SHALL MEET WITHIN 7 DAYS UPON
- 20 REQUEST OF 2 OR MORE MEMBERS OF THE GOVERNING COMMITTEE MADE TO THE
- 21 SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OR THE SENATE MAJORITY
- 22 LEADER.
- 23 (4) EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED BY SUBSECTION (5), A WRITING
- 24 PREPARED, OWNED, USED, IN THE POSSESSION OF, OR RETAINED BY THE
- 25 LEGISLATIVE BUDGET AGENCY IN THE PERFORMANCE OF AN OFFICIAL
- 26 FUNCTION MUST BE MADE AVAILABLE TO THE PUBLIC IN COMPLIANCE WITH
- 27 THE FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT, 1976 PA 442, MCL 15.231 TO 15.246.

- 1 (5) AN EMPLOYEE OF THE LEGISLATIVE BUDGET AGENCY SHALL NOT
- 2 REVEAL TO ANY PERSON WHO IS NOT AN EMPLOYEE OF THE LEGISLATIVE
- 3 BUDGET AGENCY THE CONTENTS OR NATURE OF ANY BILL, SUBSTITUTE,
- 4 AMENDMENT, RESOLUTION, SPECIAL REPORT, OR PROPOSAL NOT YET
- 5 PUBLISHED UNLESS THE EMPLOYEE HAS THE CONSENT OF THE MEMBER WHO IS
- 6 SPONSORING OR REQUESTING THE BILL, SUBSTITUTE, AMENDMENT,
- 7 RESOLUTION, SPECIAL REPORT, OR PROPOSAL. A BILL IS CONSIDERED
- 8 PUBLISHED WHEN IT IS INTRODUCED. A SUBSTITUTE, AN AMENDMENT, OR A
- 9 CONFERENCE REPORT IS CONSIDERED PUBLISHED WHEN RECEIVED BY THE
- 10 SECRETARY OF THE SENATE OR THE CLERK OF THE HOUSE OF
- 11 REPRESENTATIVES, OR BOTH, AS APPLICABLE.
- 12 (6) AN EMPLOYEE OF THE LEGISLATIVE BUDGET AGENCY IS A
- 13 NONTENURED, AT-WILL EMPLOYEE. THE GOVERNING COMMITTEE OF THE
- 14 LEGISLATIVE BUDGET AGENCY MAY DISCIPLINE, TRANSFER, DEMOTE,
- 15 SUSPEND, OR SUMMARILY DISCHARGE AN EMPLOYEE.
- 16 (7) THE LEGISLATIVE BUDGET AGENCY, THE SENATE FISCAL AGENCY,
- 17 AND THE HOUSE FISCAL AGENCY SHALL ACT IN CONCERT.
- 18 (8) THE MEMBERS OF THE GOVERNING BOARD LISTED IN SUBSECTION
- 19 (2) (A) AND (D) SHALL DESIGNATE REPRESENTATIVES FOR EACH TYPE OF
- 20 LOCAL UNIT OF GOVERNMENT TO ASSIST THE LEGISLATIVE BUDGET AGENCY IN
- 21 PREPARING FISCAL NOTES. THE REPRESENTATIVES DESCRIBED UNDER THIS
- 22 SUBSECTION MUST BE APPORTIONED ACCORDING TO THE VARIOUS POPULATION
- 23 SIZES, GEOGRAPHICAL LOCATIONS, AND UNIQUE NEEDS OF THE LOCAL UNITS
- 24 OF GOVERNMENT.
- 25 SEC. 793. (1) EXCEPT IN A STATE OF EMERGENCY DECLARED BY THE
- 26 GOVERNOR, A FISCAL BILL MUST NOT PROCEED TO THE THIRD READING IF
- 27 THE FISCAL NOTE FOR THAT FISCAL BILL CONCLUDES THAT THE COSTS FOR

- 1 COMPLIANCE WITH THAT FISCAL BILL ARE INDETERMINATE OR NOT CAPABLE
- 2 OF BEING REASONABLY ESTIMATED.
- 3 (2) A FISCAL BILL MUST NOT BE PASSED BY EITHER HOUSE OF THE
- 4 LEGISLATURE BEFORE THE MEMBERS OF THAT HOUSE HAVE BEEN PROVIDED THE
- 5 FISCAL NOTE FOR THAT FISCAL BILL AND SUFFICIENT TIME TO REVIEW THAT
- 6 FISCAL NOTE.
- 7 (3) IN EACH FISCAL NOTE, THE LEGISLATIVE BUDGET AGENCY SHALL
- 8 PROJECT COST ESTIMATES FOR A 5-YEAR PERIOD FROM THE EFFECTIVE DATE
- 9 OF A FISCAL BILL AND SHALL STATE WHETHER OR NOT COSTS OR DIVERSIONS
- 10 WILL BE INVOLVED AFTER THAT PERIOD. IF AN AMENDMENT TO A FISCAL
- 11 BILL OR A SUBSTITUTE OF A FISCAL BILL IS ADOPTED, THE LEGISLATIVE
- 12 BUDGET AGENCY SHALL UPDATE THE FISCAL NOTE FOR THAT FISCAL BILL.
- 13 SEC. 794. THE LEGISLATIVE BUDGET AGENCY SHALL PREPARE AN
- 14 ANNUAL FINANCIAL REPORT THAT RECONCILES THE COSTS ESTIMATED IN A
- 15 FISCAL NOTE WITH THE ACTUAL COSTS INCURRED AND THAT PROVIDES AN
- 16 UPDATED 5-YEAR COST ESTIMATE. THE LEGISLATIVE BUDGET AGENCY SHALL
- 17 PROVIDE THE APPROPRIATIONS COMMITTEE OF EACH CHAMBER WITH THE
- 18 ANNUAL FINANCIAL REPORT.
- 19 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
- 20 after the date it is enacted into law.
