- 1 SEC. 9E. ON OR BEFORE JANUARY 1, 2019, THE COMMISSION SHALL
- 2 DEVELOP A TRAINING PROGRAM FOR ALL LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS
- 3 REGARDING LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER CONDUCT DURING A TRAFFIC STOP.
- 4 THE TRAINING MUST, AT A MINIMUM, DIRECT LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS TO
- 5 STATE THEIR NAME AND RANK AT THE INITIAL CONTACT DURING A TRAFFIC
- 6 STOP AND PROVIDE A BUSINESS CARD WITH THE CONTACT INFORMATION OF
- 7 THE PERSON WHO WILL RECEIVE COMPLAINTS ABOUT THAT LAW ENFORCEMENT
- 8 OFFICER.
- 9 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
- 10 after the date it is enacted into law.
