## **SENATE BILL No. 847**

February 27, 2018, Introduced by Senator KNEZEK and referred to the Committee on Appropriations.

A bill to amend 1943 PA 240, entitled  $\,$ 

"State employees' retirement act,"

by amending sections 24 and 33 (MCL 38.24 and 38.33), section 24 as amended by 2002 PA 93 and section 33 as amended by 2004 PA 109.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 24. (1) Except as may otherwise be provided in sections
- 2 33 and 34, a member who becomes totally incapacitated for duty
- 3 because of a personal injury or disease that is not the natural and
- 4 proximate result of the member's performance of duty may be retired
- 5 if all of the following apply:
  - (a) The member, the member's personal representative or
  - guardian, the member's department head, or the state personnel
- director files an application on behalf of the member with the
  - retirement board no later than 1 year after termination of the

- 1 member's state employment.
- 2 (b) EITHER OF THE FOLLOWING APPLY:
- 3 (i) A medical advisor conducts a medical examination of the
- 4 member and certifies in writing that the member is mentally or
- 5 physically totally incapacitated for further performance of duty,
- 6 that the incapacitation is likely to be permanent, and that the
- 7 member should be retired.
- 8 (ii) THE MEMBER HAS A SERVICE-CONNECTED DISABILITY RATING FROM
- 9 THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF VETERANS AFFAIRS OF 100%.
- 10 (c) The member has been a state employee for at least 10
- 11 years.
- 12 (2) Upon appeal to the retirement board, the retirement board,
- 13 for good cause, may accept an application for a disability
- 14 retirement allowance not later than 2 years after termination of
- 15 the member's state employment.
- 16 Sec. 33. (1) (a) The EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN
- 17 SUBSECTION (3), THE retirement board may, and upon—ON the
- 18 application of anyone-AN INDIVIDUAL retired pursuant to-UNDER
- 19 section 21, 24, or 67a shall, require anyone—AN INDIVIDUAL retired
- 20 under section 21, 24, or 67a who has not attained age 60 years to
- 21 undergo a medical examination. The retirement board shall not
- 22 require a person AN INDIVIDUAL retired under section 21, 24, or 67a
- 23 to undergo more than 1 medical examination in any calendar year.
- 24 The examination is to be made by or under the direction of the
- 25 medical advisor at the retirant's place of residence or other place
- 26 mutually agreed upon. Should anyone—IF AN INDIVIDUAL retired under
- 27 section 21, 24, or 67a who has not attained age 60 years refuse

- 1 REFUSES to submit to the medical examination, his or her THE
- 2 INDIVIDUAL'S disability retirement allowance or supplemental
- 3 benefit provided for in section 67a may be discontinued until his
- 4 or her withdrawal of THE INDIVIDUAL WITHDRAWS the refusal. If the
- 5 refusal continues for 1 year, THE RETIREMENT BOARD MAY REVOKE all
- 6 rights in and to his or her THE INDIVIDUAL'S disability retirement
- 7 allowance or supplemental benefit provided for in section 67a. may
- 8 be revoked by the retirement board. If upon ON the medical
- 9 examination of a person AN INDIVIDUAL retired under section 21, 24,
- 10 or 67a, the medical advisor reports and his or her THE MEDICAL
- 11 ADVISOR'S report is concurred in by the retirement board, that the
- 12 person INDIVIDUAL retired under section 21, 24, or 67a is
- 13 physically capable of resuming employment, he or she shall THE
- 14 INDIVIDUAL MUST be restored to active service with the THIS state
- 15 and his or her disability retirement allowance or supplemental
- 16 benefit provided for in section 67a shall MUST cease.
- 17 (2) (b)—If the secretary reports and certifies to the
- 18 retirement board that a person AN INDIVIDUAL retired under section
- 19 21, 24, or 67a is engaged in a gainful occupation paying more than
- 20 the difference between his or her THE INDIVIDUAL'S disability
- 21 retirement allowance and his or her THE INDIVIDUAL'S final
- 22 compensation, and if the retirement board concurs in the report,
- 23 then his or her THE INDIVIDUAL'S retirement allowance shall MUST be
- 24 reduced to an amount which THAT together with the amount earned by
- 25 him or her shall equal his or her THE INDIVIDUAL EQUALS THE
- 26 INDIVIDUAL'S final compensation. Should IF the earnings of the
- 27 person-INDIVIDUAL retired under section 21, 24, or 67a be later-IS

- 1 changed, the amount of his or her THE INDIVIDUAL'S retirement
- 2 allowance shall MUST be further modified in like THE SAME manner AS
- 3 PROVIDED UNDER THIS SUBSECTION.
- 4 (3) THE MEDICAL EXAMINATION REQUIRED UNDER SUBSECTION (1) FOR
- 5 AN INDIVIDUAL RETIRED UNDER SECTION 24 DOES NOT APPLY TO A MEMBER
- 6 WHO HAS A SERVICE-CONNECTED DISABILITY RATING FROM THE UNITED
- 7 STATES DEPARTMENT OF VETERANS AFFAIRS OF 100%.
