

SENATE BILL No. 1122

September 26, 2018, Introduced by Senator JONES and referred to the Committee on Education.

A bill to amend 1976 PA 451, entitled
"The revised school code,"
(MCL 380.1 to 380.1852) by adding section 1176.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 SEC. 1176. (1) NOT LATER THAN 90 DAYS AFTER THE EFFECTIVE DATE
2 OF THE AMENDATORY ACT THAT ADDED THIS SECTION, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL
3 DEVELOP OR ADOPT A NOTICE REGARDING THE AVAILABILITY OF A
4 COMPREHENSIVE EYE AND VISION EXAMINATION FOR CHILDREN THAT HAS AN
5 EMPHASIS ON VISUAL FUNCTIONING, INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO,
6 REFRACTIVE, ACCOMMODATIVE, BINOCULAR, AND SACCADIC EYE MOVEMENT,
7 AND CONVERGENCE SUFFICIENCY.

8 (2) A SCHOOL DISTRICT, INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL DISTRICT, OR PUBLIC
9 SCHOOL ACADEMY SHALL PROVIDE TO EACH PARENT OR LEGAL GUARDIAN OF A

1 PUPIL WHO HAS AN INDIVIDUALIZED EDUCATION PROGRAM OR SECTION 504
2 PLAN OR WHO IS IN THE PROCESS OF RECEIVING AN INDIVIDUALIZED
3 EDUCATION PROGRAM OR SECTION 504 PLAN THE NOTICE DEVELOPED OR
4 ADOPTED UNDER SUBSECTION (1).

5 (3) AS USED IN THIS SECTION:

6 (A) "INDIVIDUALIZED EDUCATION PROGRAM" MEANS THAT TERM AS
7 DESCRIBED IN R 340.1721E OF THE MICHIGAN ADMINISTRATIVE CODE.

8 (B) "SECTION 504 PLAN" MEANS A PLAN UNDER SECTION 504 OF TITLE
9 V OF THE REHABILITATION ACT OF 1973, 29 USC 794.

10 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
11 after the date it is enacted into law.
