## **SENATE BILL No. 1122**

September 26, 2018, Introduced by Senator JONES and referred to the Committee on Education.

A bill to amend 1976 PA 451, entitled "The revised school code,"

(MCL 380.1 to 380.1852) by adding section 1176.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 1176. (1) NOT LATER THAN 90 DAYS AFTER THE EFFECTIVE DATE
- 2 OF THE AMENDATORY ACT THAT ADDED THIS SECTION, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL
- 3 DEVELOP OR ADOPT A NOTICE REGARDING THE AVAILABILITY OF A
- 4 COMPREHENSIVE EYE AND VISION EXAMINATION FOR CHILDREN THAT HAS AN
- 5 EMPHASIS ON VISUAL FUNCTIONING, INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO,
- 6 REFRACTIVE, ACCOMMODATIVE, BINOCULAR, AND SACCADIC EYE MOVEMENT,
- 7 AND CONVERGENCE SUFFICIENCY.
- 8 (2) A SCHOOL DISTRICT, INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL DISTRICT, OR PUBLIC
  - SCHOOL ACADEMY SHALL PROVIDE TO EACH PARENT OR LEGAL GUARDIAN OF A
