ENROLLED SENATE BILL No. 1137

AN ACT to amend 2001 PA 142, entitled "An act to consolidate prior acts naming certain Michigan highways; to provide for the naming of certain highways; to prescribe certain duties of the state transportation department; and to repeal acts and parts of acts and certain resolutions," (MCL 250.1001 to 250.2080) by adding section 36a.


The People of the State of Michigan enact:

Sec. 36a. The portion of highway M-10 located in the city of Detroit between the intersection with Meyers Road and the intersection with West Outer Drive shall be known as the "Violet T. Lewis Memorial Highway".

Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days after the date it is enacted into law.
