CONTENT

The bill would amend the Revised Judicature Act to prescribe the venue for an action involving personal injury protection (PIP) or PIP benefits.

Specifically, the bill specifies that in an action for PIP or property protection insurance benefits, the county in which the original injury occurred or in which the plaintiff resided would be the county in which to file and try the action.
