SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 5976

A bill to amend 1973 PA 116, entitled

"An act to provide for the protection of children through the licensing and regulation of child care organizations; to provide for the establishment of standards of care for child care organizations; to prescribe powers and duties of certain departments of this state and adoption facilitators; to provide penalties; and to repeal acts and parts of acts,"

(MCL 722.111 to 722.128) by adding section 4c.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 4c. (1) With the written approval from the department, an
- 2 operator of a family child care home or group child care home who
- 3 has a regular license with no pending disciplinary action,
- 4 including, but not limited to, a provisional license, refusal to
- 5 renew, or revocation or increased monitoring due to violation of a





- 1 rule or law, may submit a written request to the department to care
- 2 for additional unrelated school-age children during before- or
- 3 after-school hours.
- 4 (2) Upon approval from the department, a family child care
- 5 home or group child care home may care for 2 additional unrelated
- 6 school-age children during before- or after-school care hours. The
- 7 existing square footage requirement must be met to obtain
- 8 departmental approval.
- 9 (3) The department shall rescind the written approval of 2
- 10 additional school-age children for an operator of a family child
- 11 care home or group child care home if a recommendation is made for
- 12 disciplinary action, as described in subsection (1), including, but
- 13 not limited to, increased monitoring of that license due to
- 14 substantial or willful violation of a rule or law.
- 15 (4) While providing before- or after-school care, an operator
- 16 of a family child care home or group child care home approved under
- 17 this section is exempt from counting up to 2 additional unrelated
- 18 school-age children in the ratio of child care personnel to
- 19 children as allowed in the administrative rules.
- 20 (5) As used in this section:
- 21 (a) "Before- or after-school care" means child care during the
- 22 hours of 5 a.m. to 9 a.m. and 2:30 p.m. to 6 p.m. on school days.
- 23 Before- or after-school care does not apply to a school break from
- 24 regularly scheduled classes, including spring, summer, and winter
- 25 break, or when school is closed for observing a state or federal
- 26 holiday or a snow day.
- 27 (b) "Child care personnel" means an individual who is 14 years
- 28 of age or older to whom 1 or more of the following apply:
- 29 (i) The individual is employed by a family child care home or

- group child care home for compensation, including a contract employee or a self-employed individual.
- (ii) An individual whose activities involve the unsupervised
 care or supervision of children for a family child care home or
 group child care home.
- 6 (iii) An individual who has unsupervised access to children who
 7 are cared for or supervised by a family child care home or group
 8 child care home.
- 9 (iv) An individual who acts in the role of a licensee designee.
