HOUSE BILL NO. 4041

January 15, 2019, Introduced by Reps. Calley, Brann and Sabo and referred to the Committee on Regulatory Reform.

A bill to amend 1931 PA 328, entitled "The Michigan penal code,"

by amending sections 42b and 470 (MCL 750.42b and 750.470), section 42b as added by 1992 PA 273 and section 470 as amended by 1998 PA 38.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 42b. (1) Except as provided in subsection (3), a person
- 2 shall not sell or distribute a tobacco product or tobacco

- 1 paraphernalia in this state through the use of the United States
- 2 mail service, express mail service, parcel post service, or any
- 3 common carrier service except to persons who have previously paid
- 4 or agreed to pay for the products at fair market value. This
- 5 subsection shall does not be construed to apply to any person
- 6 employed by the United States postal service Postal Service or by
- 7 any common carrier while carrying or delivering a tobacco product
- 8 or tobacco paraphernalia mailed or shipped by another person.

- 9 (2) A person shall not, as part of his, her, or its business,
 10 either directly or through an agent, distribute tobacco products or
 11 tobacco paraphernalia to persons who did not previously pay or
 12 agree to pay for the products unless all of the following
 13 provisions are met:
 - (a) The person or agent distributing the tobacco product or tobacco paraphernalia distributes only tobacco products or tobacco paraphernalia regularly sold or manufactured by that person or agent.
 - (b) The person distributing the tobacco product **or tobacco paraphernalia** ascertains that the person receiving the tobacco product **or tobacco** paraphernalia is 18—21 years of age or older.
 - (c) The person receiving the tobacco product or tobacco paraphernalia is physically present to receive the product.
 - (d) Distribution is not prohibited by any local ordinance.
 - (3) Subsection (1) does not prohibit the sale or distribution of a tobacco product or tobacco paraphernalia in this state through the use of the United States mail service, express mail service, parcel post service, or any common carrier service if the sale or distribution is in response to a consumer complaint or is part of a direct mail marketing of products to specifically named

- 6 the use of a vending machine, or install or maintain a vending
- 7 machine with the intent of selling or distributing cigarettes,
- 8 cigars, or other tobacco products or tobacco paraphernalia. For
- 9 purposes of this section, "place of public accommodation" has the
- 10 same meaning as that term has in section 301(a) of the persons with
- 11 disabilities civil rights act, 1976 PA 220, MCL 37.1301.
- 12 (2) This Until June 30, 2019, this section does not apply to a
- 13 cigarette tobacco products or tobacco paraphernalia vending machine
- 14 that meets either any of the following criteria:
- 15 (a) The tobacco products or tobacco paraphernalia vending
- 16 machine is a cigarette vending machine that is located in an
- 17 establishment that has a class C license as defined in section 2t
- 18 107 of the Michigan liquor control act, 1933 (Ex Sess) code of
- 19 1998, 1998 PA 8, 58, MCL 436.2t, 436.1107, and 1 of the following
- 20 applies:
- 21 (i) If the establishment has a bar that is located in a room
- 22 that is separated from the remainder of the establishment by a wall
- 23 and a doorway, the cigarette vending machine is located entirely in

- 25 (ii) If the establishment has a bar that is not located in a
- 26 room that is separated from the remainder of the establishment by a
- 27 wall and a doorway, the cigarette vending machine is located not
- 28 more than 20 feet from the bar, is located clearly within the bar
- 29 area and not in a hallway, coat room, rest room, or similar

- unrelated area, and is under the direct visual supervision of an
 adult.
- 3 (b) The tobacco products or tobacco paraphernalia vending
 4 machine is a cigarette vending machine that is located entirely in
 5 an area, office, plant, factory, or private membership club that is
 6 not open to the public, and is located not less than 20 feet from
 7 all entrances and exits that are accessible to the general public.
 - (c) The tobacco products or tobacco paraphernalia vending machine is located in a place of public accommodation to which access by individuals under 21 years of age is prohibited by law.

 12 misdemeanor —punishable by imprisonment 1 or more of the
 13 following:

- 20 (4) Each day that a person has a vending machine that
