THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 905a. (1) Except as provided in subsection (2), a person
- 2 licensed under this act to sell alcoholic liquor for consumption on
- 3 or off the licensed premises at retail shall post in a conspicuous
- 4 location a sign informing the public of the effects of alcohol

- 1 consumption during pregnancy. The sign must contain the message:
- 2 "Pregnancy and alcohol do not mix. Drinking alcoholic beverages
- 3 during pregnancy can cause birth defects.". The commission shall
- 4 develop and furnish the sign.
- 5 (2) If the person described in subsection (1) sells alcoholic
- 6 liquor for consumption on the licensed premises, instead of posting
- 7 a sign the person may place the message required by subsection (1)
- 8 on a menu.
- 9 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 180 days
- 10 after the date it is enacted into law.
