(MCL 380.1 to 380.1852) by adding section 1278f.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1278f. A pupil may satisfy the credit requirements in
- 2 21st century skills for a high school diploma under section
- 3 1278a(1)(a)(iv) by successfully completing any combination of 3
- 4 credits in the following:
- 5 (a) A language other than English. A pupil may complete 1 or





- 1 more credits in a language other than English by completing, at any
- 2 time during grades K to 12, 1 or more credits that are grade-
- 3 appropriate in a language other than English or coursework or other
- 4 learning experiences that are substantially equivalent to credits
- 5 in a language other than English, based on guidelines developed by
- 6 the department. For the purposes of this subdivision, all of the
- 7 following apply:
- 8 (i) American Sign Language is considered to be a language other
- 9 than English.
- 10 (\ddot{u}) The pupil may satisfy all or part of the requirements for
- 11 a credit in a language other than English with online coursework.
- 12 (b) Visual arts, performing arts, or applied arts, as defined
- 13 by the department. A school district or public school academy is
- 14 strongly encouraged to offer visual arts and performing arts
- 15 courses.
- 16 (c) Computer science or computer coding, or a combination of
- 17 these.
- 18 (d) A department-approved formal career and technical
- 19 education program.
