## **HOUSE BILL NO. 4361**

March 13, 2019, Introduced by Reps. Sheppard and LaGrand and referred to the Committee on Natural Resources and Outdoor Recreation.

A bill to amend 1994 PA 451, entitled "Natural resources and environmental protection act," by amending section 43532 (MCL 324.43532), as amended by 2016 PA 463.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 43532. (1) An all-species fishing license entitles the licensee to take and possess all aquatic species as prescribed by law.
- 4 (2) An Except as otherwise provided in subsection (3), an
  5 individual 17 years of age or older shall not take or possess an





- 1 aquatic species, except aquatic insects, in the waters over which
- 2 this state has jurisdiction without a license. The fee for a
- 3 resident all-species fishing license is \$25.00. The fee for a
- 4 nonresident all-species fishing license is \$75.00.
- 5 (3) An individual who resides on a qualified private lake is
- 6 not required to obtain an all-species fishing license while fishing
- 7 on that qualified private lake. An individual shall possess his or
- 8 her driver license, state personal identification card, or other
- 9 proof that he or she resides on the qualified private lake while
- 10 fishing under this subsection.
- 11 (4) (3) Not later than March 1, 2018, the The department shall
- 12 develop an electronic license that allows an individual to display
- 13 an electronic copy of his or her all-species fishing license using
- 14 an electronic device.
- 15 (5) As used in this section, "qualified private lake" means a
- 16 lake that meets both of the following:
- 17 (a) There is no public access to that lake.
- 18 (b) Individuals who reside on the lake pay a fee to an
- 19 association or group that uses that fee, or a portion of that fee,
- 20 to stock fish in the lake.
