

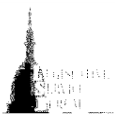
# HOUSE BILL NO. 4375

A bill to amend 1954 PA 116, entitled  
"Michigan election law,"  
by amending section 293 (MCL 168.293).

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1       Sec. 293. Any member of ~~said boards~~ **the state board of**  
2 **education, board of regents of the University of Michigan, board of**  
3 **trustees of Michigan State University, or board of governors of**  
4 **Wayne State University** may be removed from office upon conviction



1 in impeachment proceedings for the reasons and in the manner set  
 2 forth in section 7 of article ~~11~~ **XI** of the state constitution **of**  
 3 **1963**. The governor ~~shall have~~ **has** the power and it ~~shall be~~ **is** his  
 4 **or her** duty ~~, except at such time as the legislature may be in~~  
 5 ~~session,~~ to examine into the condition and administration of the  
 6 ~~said boards and the acts of the members enumerated herein of the~~  
 7 **boards** and to remove from office for gross neglect of duty or for  
 8 corrupt conduct in office, or any other misfeasance or malfeasance  
 9 ~~therein, in office,~~ and report the causes of ~~such the~~ removal to  
 10 the legislature. ~~at its next session. Such person shall~~ **The**  
 11 **individual must** be served with a written notice of the charges  
 12 against him **or her** and be afforded an opportunity for a public  
 13 hearing conducted personally by the governor.

14 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days  
 15 after the date it is enacted into law.
