by amending the title and section 1 (MCL 15.151).

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

TITLE

An act to require employees and persons in the service of the

state and its governmental agencies to take and subscribe to the

constitutional oath of office; to provide for the powers and duties





- 1 of certain state officers and agencies; and to provide remedies for
- 2 the failure to take and subscribe to the constitutional oath of
- 3 office.
- 4 Sec. 1. (1) All persons individuals now employed, or who may
- 5 be employed by the this state of Michigan or any governmental
- 6 agency thereof, of this state, and all other persons individuals in
- 7 the service of the this state or any governmental agency of this
- 8 state, shall, as a condition of their employment, take and
- 9 subscribe to the oath or affirmation required of members of the
- 10 legislature and other public officers by section 2 of article 16 of
- 11 the constitution of 1908 of the state of Michigan.section 1 of
- 12 article XI of the state constitution of 1963.
- 13 (2) The oath or affirmation required to be taken and
- 14 subscribed to by an individual under subsection (1) must be
- 15 administered by a member of the legislature or public officer
- 16 described in subsection (1) who is the individual's superior within
- 17 this state or the governmental agency.
- 18 (3) This state or a governmental agency of this state shall
- 19 not pay any compensation, remuneration, or reimbursement to an
- 20 individual described in subsection (1) unless the individual has
- 21 taken and subscribed to the oath or affirmation required under
- 22 subsection (1). The individual shall remit to this state or the
- 23 respective governmental agency any compensation, remuneration, or
- 24 reimbursement the individual received from this state or the
- 25 governmental agency before taking and subscribing to the oath or
- 26 affirmation.
- 27 (4) Unless an individual described in subsection (1) takes and
- 28 subscribes to the oath of affirmation, the individual does not have
- 29 authority to act on behalf of this state or the governmental



- 1 agency. Any actions taken by the individual on behalf of this state
- 2 or the governmental agency before taking and subscribing to the
- 3 oath or affirmation are void.
- 4 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
- 5 after the date it is enacted into law.
