HOUSE BILL NO. 4702

June 11, 2019, Introduced by Reps. Chirkun and Cambensy and referred to the Committee on Government Operations.

A bill to amend 1976 PA 331, entitled "Michigan consumer protection act,"

(MCL 445.901 to 445.922) by adding section 9b; and to repeal acts and parts of acts.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 9b. (1) The attorney general shall investigate pricing of
- 2 prescription insulin drugs made available to residents of this
- 3 state to ensure adequate consumer protections in pricing of
- 4 prescription insulin drugs and whether additional consumer





- 1 protections are needed.
- 2 (2) As part of the investigation described in subsection (1),
- 3 the attorney general shall gather, compile, and analyze information
- 4 concerning the organization, business practices, pricing
- 5 information, data, reports, or other information that the attorney
- 6 general finds necessary to fulfill the requirements of this section
- 7 from persons engaged in the manufacture or sale of prescription
- 8 insulin drugs. The attorney general shall also consider any
- 9 publicly available information related to drug pricing.
- 10 (3) If necessary to fulfill the reporting requirements of this
- 11 section, subject to subsection (4), the attorney general may issue
- 12 an administrative subpoena that requires any of the following to
- 13 furnish material, answers, data, or other information that is
- 14 relevant to the investigation:
- 15 (a) Another state officer, department, or agency.
- 16 (b) A pharmacy benefits manager or other carrier.
- 17 (c) A manufacturer of prescription insulin drugs that are made
- 18 available in this state.
- 19 (4) A person is not required to provide or disclose trade
- 20 secrets in connection with an investigation under subsection (1).
- 21 (5) By November 1, 2020, the attorney general shall issue and
- 22 make available to the public a report detailing his or her findings
- 23 from the investigation conducted under this section. The attorney
- 24 general shall present the report to the governor, the director of
- 25 the department of insurance and financial services, and the
- 26 standing committees of the senate and house of representatives with
- 27 primary responsibility for insurance and health policy issues. The
- 28 report must include all of the following:
- 29 (a) A summary of insulin pricing practices and variables that



- 1 contribute to pricing of health coverage plans.
- 2 (b) Public policy recommendations to control and prevent
- 3 overpricing of prescription insulin drugs made available to
- 4 residents of this state.
- 5 (c) Any recommendations for amendments to this act to prevent
- 6 unfair, unconscionable, or deceptive methods, acts, or practices in
- 7 the conduct of trade or commerce related to the sale of
- 8 prescription insulin drugs, including the pricing of those drugs.
- 9 (d) Any other information the attorney general finds necessary 10 to include.
- 11 (6) As used in this section:
- 12 (a) "Carrier" means that term as defined in section 3701 of
- 13 the insurance code of 1956, 1956 PA 218, MCL 500.3701.
- 14 (b) "Prescription insulin drug" means a prescription drug, as
- 15 that term is defined in section 17708 of the public health code,
- 16 1978 PA 368, MCL 333.17708, that contains insulin and is used to
- 17 treat diabetes.
- 18 (c) "Trade secret" means that term as defined in section 2 of
- 19 the uniform trade secrets act, 1998 PA 448, MCL 445.1902.
- 20 Enacting section 1. Section 9b of the Michigan consumer
- 21 protection act, 1976 PA 331, MCL 445.909b, is repealed effective
- 22 December 1, 2020.
- 23 Enacting section 2. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
- 24 after the date it is enacted into law.
