HOUSE BILL NO. 4825

August 13, 2019, Introduced by Reps. Koleszar and Shannon and referred to the Committee on Tax Policy.

A bill to amend 1937 PA 94, entitled "Use tax act,"

(MCL 205.91 to 205.111) by adding section 4ff.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 4ff. (1) Subject to subsection (2), the tax under this
- 2 act does not apply to the sale of any of the following items if the
- 3 sale is made between 12:01 a.m. and 11:59 p.m. on the third
- 4 Saturday of August each year:
- 5 (a) Clothing if the sales price of each individual item is not
- 6 greater than \$100.00.





- 1 (b) School supplies if the sales price of each individual item 2 is not greater than \$20.00.
- 3 (c) A personal computer purchased for noncommercial home or
- 4 personal use, if the sales price, less any manufacturer's rebate,
- 5 of each individual personal computer is not greater than \$1,000.00.
- 6 (d) A personal computer accessory purchased for noncommercial
- 7 home or personal use, if the sales price, less any manufacturer's
- 8 rebate, of each individual personal computer accessory is not
- 9 greater than \$500.00.
- 10 (2) The exemption in subsection (1) does not apply to the
- 11 following:
- 12 (a) Clothing accessories or equipment.
- (b) Protective, sport, or recreational equipment.
- 14 (c) Any item sold for use in a trade or business.
- 15 (d) Furniture.
- 16 (3) As used in this section:
- 17 (a) "Clothing" means any article of wearing apparel, including
- 18 all footwear, intended to be worn on or about the human body.
- (b) "Clothing accessories or equipment" means incidental items
- 20 worn on the person or in conjunction with clothing, including, but
- 21 not limited to, watches, watchbands, jewelry, umbrellas, or
- 22 handkerchiefs.
- 23 (c) "Monitor" does not include a device that includes a
- 24 television tuner.
- 25 (d) "Personal computer" means an electronic device that
- 26 accepts information in digital or similar form and manipulates that
- 27 information for a result based on a sequence of instructions.
- 28 Personal computer includes, but is not limited to, an electronic
- 29 book reader or a laptop, desktop, handheld, tablet, or tower



- 1 computer. Personal computer does not include a cellular telephone,
- 2 video game console, digital media receiver, or any other device not
- 3 primarily designed to process data.
- 4 (e) "Personal computer accessory" includes a keyboard, mouse,
- 5 personal digital assistant, monitor, peripheral device, modem,
- 6 router, and nonrecreational software, regardless of whether the
- 7 personal computer accessory is used in association with a personal
- 8 computer. Personal computer accessory does not include any system,
- 9 device, software, or peripheral device that is designed or intended
- 10 primarily for recreational use.
- 11 (f) "Protective, sport, or recreational equipment" means items
- 12 designed for human use and worn in conjunction with an athletic or
- 13 recreational activity and that are not suitable for general use,
- 14 including, but not limited to, skis, swim fins, rollerblades, and
- 15 skates.
- 16 (g) "School supplies" means pens, pencils, erasers, crayons,
- 17 notebooks, notebook filler paper, legal pads, binders, lunch boxes,
- 18 construction paper, markers, folders, poster board, composition
- 19 books, poster paper, scissors, cellophane tape, glue, paste,
- 20 rulers, computer disks, protractors, compasses, calculators, and
- 21 similar items.
