## **HOUSE BILL NO. 5007**

September 24, 2019, Introduced by Reps. Haadsma, Hood, Pohutsky, LaGrand, Pagan, Rabhi, Brixie, Wittenberg, Kuppa, Lasinski, Sabo, Sowerby, Cynthia Johnson, Love, Warren, Stone, Anthony, Gay-Dagnogo and Peterson and referred to the Committee on Natural Resources and Outdoor Recreation.

A bill to amend 1994 PA 451, entitled "Natural resources and environmental protection act," (MCL 324.101 to 324.90106) by adding section 16309.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 16309. (1) The recycling initiative fund is created within the state treasury.
- 3 (2) The state treasurer may receive money or other assets from 4 any source for deposit into the fund. The state treasurer shall
- 5 direct the investment of the fund. The state treasurer shall credit

- 1 to the fund interest and earnings from fund investments. Money in
- 2 the fund at the close of the fiscal year shall remain in the fund
- 3 and shall not lapse to the general fund. The department of
- 4 environment, Great Lakes, and energy shall be the administrator of
- 5 the fund for auditing purposes.
- 6 (3) The department of environment, Great Lakes, and energy
- 7 shall expend money from the fund, upon appropriation, only for 1 or
- 8 more of the following purposes:
- 9 (a) To promote the recycling of or reduce the use of
- 10 disposable containers, packaging, and bags.
- 11 (b) For grants to municipalities to increase recycling
- 12 capacity and participation or for waste reduction.
- 13 (c) For administration and enforcement of and public education
- 14 concerning the polystyrene foam program under this part.
- 15 (d) For programs, or grants to municipalities and nonprofit
- 16 organizations, to clean up litter composed in whole or in part of
- 17 disposable containers, packaging, or bags.
- 18 (e) For programs, or grants to municipalities, universities,
- 19 or nonprofit organizations, to research recycling and waste
- 20 reduction.
- 21 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
- 22 after the date it is enacted into law.
- 23 Enacting section 2. This amendatory act does not take effect
- 24 unless Senate Bill No. or House Bill No. 5006 (request no.
- 25 03535'19) of the 100th Legislature is enacted into law.
