## **HOUSE BILL NO. 5161**

October 24, 2019, Introduced by Reps. Bellino, Hammoud, Manoogian, Shannon, Liberati, Green and Bolden and referred to the Committee on Regulatory Reform.

A bill to prohibit the sale of vapor products or alternative nicotine products that contain vitamin E acetate; and to prescribe penalties.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 3. As used in this act:
- 2 (a) "Alternative nicotine product" means a noncombustible
- 3 product that contains nicotine that is intended for human
- 4 consumption, whether chewed, absorbed, dissolved, or ingested by
- 5 any other means. Alternative nicotine product does not include a
- 6 tobacco product, a vapor product, food, or a product regulated as a

  2 under 21 USC 351 to 360fff-7.
- 3 (g) "Vapor product" means a noncombustible product that
- 4 employs a heating element, power source, electronic circuit, or
- 5 other electronic, chemical, or mechanical means, regardless of
- 6 shape or size, that can be used to produce vapor from nicotine or
- 7 any other substance, and the use or inhalation of which simulates
- 8 smoking. Vapor product includes an electronic cigarette, electronic
- 9 cigar, electronic cigarillo, electronic pipe, or similar product or
- 10 device and a vapor cartridge or other container of nicotine or
- 11 other substance in a solution or other form that is intended to be
- 12 used with or in an electronic cigarette, electronic cigar,
- 13 electronic cigarillo, electronic pipe, or similar product or
- 14 device. Vapor product does not include a product regulated as a
- 15 drug or device by the United States Food and Drug Administration
- 16 under 21 USC 351 to 360fff-7.
- Sec. 5. (1) A person shall not sell a vapor product or
- 18 alternative nicotine product that contains vitamin E acetate or has
- 19 been combined with vitamin E acetate.
- 20 (2) A person who violates subsection (1) is guilty of a
- 21 misdemeanor punishable by a fine as follows:
- 22 (a) For a first offense, not more than \$100.00.
- (b) For a second offense, not more than \$500.00.
- (c) For a third or subsequent offense, not more than
- **25** \$2,500.00.
