## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 3406w. (1) An insurer that delivers, issues for delivery,
- 2 or renews in this state a health insurance policy shall provide
- 3 coverage for all of the following:
- 4 (a) Ambulatory patient services.
- 5 (b) Emergency services.
- 6 (c) Hospitalization.





- 1 (d) Pregnancy, maternity, and newborn care.
- 2 (e) Mental health and substance use disorder services,
- 3 including behavioral health treatment.
  - (f) Prescription drugs.

- 5 (g) Rehabilitative and habilitative services and devices.
- 6 (h) Laboratory services.
- 7 (i) Preventive and wellness services and chronic disease 8 management, including, but not limited to, all of the following:
- 9 (i) Evidence-based items or services that have in effect a
  10 rating of "A" or "B" in the current recommendations of the United
  11 States Preventive Services Task Force.
- 12 (ii) Immunizations that have in effect a recommendation from
  13 the Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices of the Centers for
  14 Disease Control and Prevention with respect to the individual
  15 involved.
- 16 (iii) With respect to infants, children, and adolescents,
  17 evidence-informed preventive care and screenings provided for in
  18 the comprehensive guidelines supported by the Health Resources and
  19 Services Administration.
- 20 (*iv*) With respect to women, additional preventive care and 21 screenings not described in subparagraph (*i*) as provided for in 22 comprehensive guidelines supported by the Health Resources and 23 Services Administration.
- 24 (j) Pediatric services, including oral and vision care.
- 25 (2) Benefits provided under subsection (1) are subject to all 26 requirements applicable to those benefits under this chapter.
- 27 (3) This section does not limit the requirements to provide 28 additional benefits under this chapter.
