HOUSE BILL NO. 5697

March 17, 2020, Introduced by Reps. Howell and Filler and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

A bill to amend 1994 PA 451, entitled "Natural resources and environmental protection act," by amending sections 40118 and 43558 (MCL 324.40118 and 324.43558), section 40118 as amended by 2017 PA 124 and section 43558 as amended by 2013 PA 108.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 40118. (1) An individual who violates this part, an order or interim order issued under this part, or a condition of a permit issued under this part, except for a violation specified in





- 1 subsections (2) to $\frac{(18)}{(19)}$, is guilty of a misdemeanor
- 2 punishable by imprisonment for not more than 90 days τ or a fine of
- 3 not less than \$50.00 or more than \$500.00, or both, and the costs
- 4 of prosecution. In addition, a permit issued by the department
- 5 under this part must be revoked pursuant to the administrative
- 6 procedures act of 1969, 1969 PA 306, MCL 24.201 to 24.328.
- 7 (2) An individual who violates a provision of this part or an
- 8 order or interim order issued under this part regarding the
- 9 possession or taking of any game, except deer, bear, wild turkey,
- 10 wolf, waterfowl, moose, or elk, is guilty of a misdemeanor
- 11 punishable by imprisonment for not more than 90 days or a fine of
- 12 not less than \$100.00 or more than \$1,000.00, or both, and the
- 13 costs of prosecution.
- 14 (3) Except as otherwise provided in this subsection, an
- 15 individual who violates a provision of this part or an order or
- 16 interim order issued under this part regarding the possession or
- 17 taking of deer, bear, wild turkey, or wolf is guilty of a
- 18 misdemeanor and shall be punished by imprisonment for not less than
- 19 5 days or more than 90 days τ and a fine of not less than \$200.00
- 20 or more than \$1,000.00, and the costs of prosecution. An individual
- 21 shall not be punished under this subsection for lawfully removing,
- 22 capturing, or destroying a wolf under 2008 PA 290, MCL 324.95151 to
- 23 324.95155, or 2008 PA 318, MCL 324.95161 to 324.95167.
- 24 (4) An individual who violates a provision of this part or an
- 25 order or interim order issued under this part regarding the
- 26 possession or taking of elk is quilty of a misdemeanor punishable
- 27 by imprisonment for not less than 30 days or more than 180 days τ
- 28 or a fine of not less than \$500.00 or more than \$2,000.00, or both,
- 29 and the costs of prosecution.



- 1 (5) An individual who violates a provision of this part or an order or interim order issued under this part regarding the possession or taking of moose is guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by imprisonment for not less than 90 days or more than 1 year and a fine of not less than \$1,000.00 or more than \$5,000.00, and the costs of prosecution.
- 7 (6) An individual who violates a provision of this part or an 8 order or interim order issued under this part regarding the possession or taking of waterfowl is quilty of a misdemeanor 9 10 punishable by imprisonment for not more than 90 days or a fine of 11 not less than \$250.00 or more than \$500.00, or both, and the costs of prosecution. An individual who violates a provision of this part 12 or an order or interim order issued under this part regarding the 13 possession or taking of waterfowl a second or subsequent time is 14 15 quilty of a misdemeanor punishable by imprisonment for not more 16 than 90 days or a fine of \$500.00, or both, and the costs of 17 prosecution.
 - (7) An individual sentenced under subsection (3), (14), or (15) shall not secure or possess a license of any kind to hunt during the remainder of the year in which convicted and the next 3 succeeding calendar years. An individual sentenced under subsection (11) shall not secure or possess a license to hunt during the remainder of the year in which convicted and the next succeeding calendar year, or longer in the discretion of the court.
 - (8) In addition to the penalties provided for violating this part or an order issued under this part, an individual convicted of the illegal killing, possessing, purchasing, or selling of a bear or an antlered white-tailed deer is subject to the following penalties:



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- (a) For a first offense, the individual shall not secure or
 possess a license of any kind to hunt for an additional 2 calendar
 years after the penalties imposed under subsection (7).
- 4 (b) For a second or subsequent offense, the individual shall
 5 not secure or possess a license of any kind to hunt for an
 6 additional 7 calendar years after the penalties imposed under
 7 subsection (7).
- 8 (9) In addition to the penalties provided for violating this
 9 part or an order issued under this part, an individual convicted of
 10 the illegal killing, possessing, purchasing, or selling of a wild
 11 turkey shall not secure or possess a license of any kind to hunt
 12 for an additional 2 calendar years after the penalties imposed
 13 under subsection (7).
- 14 (10) An individual sentenced under subsection (4) or (5) is
 15 subject to the following penalties:
- 16 (a) For a first offense, the individual shall not secure or
 17 possess a license of any kind to hunt for the remainder of the year
 18 in which convicted and the next 15 succeeding calendar years.
- (b) For a second offense, the individual shall not secure or
 possess a license of any kind to hunt for the remainder of that
 individual's life.
- (11) An individual who violates section 40113(1) is guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by imprisonment for not less than 5 days or more than 90 days —or a fine of not less than \$100.00 or more than \$500.00, or both, and the costs of prosecution.
- 26 (12) An individual who violates section 40113(2) is guilty of
 27 a misdemeanor punishable by imprisonment for not more than 90 days
 28 or a fine of not less than \$50.00 or more than \$500.00, or both,
 29 and the costs of prosecution.



- 1 (13) An individual who violates section 40113(3) is guilty of 2 a misdemeanor punishable by imprisonment for not less than 5 days 3 or more than 90 days and a fine of not less than \$100.00 or more 4 than \$500.00, and the costs of prosecution.
- 5 (14) An individual who violates a provision of this part or an 6 order or interim order issued under this part regarding the taking 7 or possession of an animal that has been designated by the 8 department to be a protected animal, other than an animal that 9 appears on a list prepared under section 36505, is quilty of a 10 misdemeanor punishable by imprisonment for not more than 90 days or a fine of not less than \$100.00 or more than \$1,000.00, or both, 11 and the costs of prosecution. 12
 - (15) An individual who buys or sells game or a protected animal in violation of this part or an order or interim order issued under this part is guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by imprisonment for not more than 90 days or a fine of not more than \$1,000.00, or both, for the first offense, and is guilty of a felony for each subsequent offense.
 - (16) An individual who willfully violates a provision of this part or an order or interim order issued under this part by using an illegally constructed snare or cable restraint is guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by imprisonment for not more than 90 days τ or a fine of \$1,000.00 for the first illegally constructed snare or cable restraint and \$250.00 for each subsequent illegally constructed snare or cable restraint, or both, and the costs of prosecution.
- (17) An individual who violates a provision of this part or an
 order or interim order issued under this part regarding the
 importation of a cervid carcass or parts of a cervid carcass, other



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- 1 than hides, deboned meat, quarters or other parts of a cervid that
- 2 do not have any part of the spinal column or head attached,
- 3 finished taxidermy products, cleaned teeth, antlers, or antlers
- 4 attached to a skullcap cleaned of brain and muscle tissue, from
- 5 another state or province is guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by
- 6 imprisonment for not more than 90 days or a fine of not less than
- 7 \$500.00 or more than \$2,000.00, or both, and the costs of
- 8 prosecution.
- 9 (18) If an individual is convicted of a violation of this part
- 10 or an order or interim order issued under this part and it is
- 11 alleged in the complaint and proved or admitted at trial or
- 12 ascertained by the court after conviction that the individual had
- 13 been previously convicted 2 times within the preceding 5 years for
- 14 a violation of this part or an order or interim order issued under
- 15 this part, the individual is guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by
- 16 imprisonment for not less than 10 days or more than 180 days —and
- 17 a fine of not less than \$500.00 or more than \$2,000.00, and costs
- 18 of prosecution.
- 19 (19) An individual who violates a provision of this part or an
- 20 order or interim order issued under this part regarding any of the
- 21 following is responsible for a state civil infraction and may be
- 22 ordered to pay a civil fine of \$150.00:
- (a) Attaching that individual's name, driver license number,
- 24 or sportcard number to a ground blind.
- 25 (b) Attaching that individual's name, driver license number,
- 26 or sportcard number to a tree stand, scaffold, or raised platform.
- 27 (c) Supplemental feeding of deer.
- Sec. 43558. (1) A person is guilty of a misdemeanor if the
- 29 person does any of the following:



- (a) Makes a false statement as to material facts for the
 purpose of obtaining a license or uses or attempts to use a license
 obtained by making a false statement.
- 4 (b) Affixes to a license a date or time other than the date or5 time issued.
- 6 (c) Issues a license without receiving and remitting the fee7 to the department.
- 8 (d) Without Except as otherwise provided in this section,
 9 without a license, takes or possesses a wild animal, wild bird, or
 10 aquatic species, except aquatic insects. This subdivision does not
 11 apply to a person an individual less than 17 years of age who
 12 without a license takes or possesses aquatic species.
- (e) Sells, loans, or permits in any manner another person individual to use the person's individual's license or uses or attempts to use another person's individual's license.
- 16 (f) Falsely makes, alters, forges, or counterfeits a sportcard
 17 or a hunting, fishing, or fur harvester's license or possesses an
 18 altered, forged, or counterfeited hunting, fishing, or fur
 19 harvester's license.
- 20 (g) Uses a tag furnished with a deer license, bear hunting
 21 license, elk hunting license, or wild turkey hunting license more
 22 than 1 time, or attaches or allows a tag to be attached to a deer,
 23 bear, elk, or turkey other than a deer, bear, elk, or turkey
 24 lawfully killed by the person.individual.
- 25 (h) Except as provided by law, makes an application for,
 26 obtains, or purchases more than 1 license for a hunting, fishing,
 27 or trapping season, not including a limited fishing license, second
 28 deer license, antlerless deer license, or other license
 29 specifically authorized by law, or if the applicant's license has



1 been lost or destroyed.

- 2 (i) Applies for, obtains, or purchases a license during a time
 3 that the person individual is ineligible to secure a license.
- 4 (j) Knowingly obtains, or attempts to obtain, a resident or a
 5 senior license if that person individual is not a resident of this
 6 state.
 - (2) Except as provided in subsection (5), a person who violates subsection (1) shall be punished by imprisonment for not more than 90 days or a fine of not less than \$25.00 or more than \$250.00 and the costs of prosecution, or both. In addition, the person shall surrender any license and license tag that was wrongfully obtained.
 - (3) A person An individual licensed to carry a firearm under this part is prohibited from doing so while under the influence of a controlled substance or alcohol or a combination of a controlled substance and alcohol. A person An individual who violates this subsection is guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by imprisonment for 90 days or a fine of \$500.00, or both.
 - (4) An applicant for a license under this part who has previously been convicted of a violation of the game and fish laws of this state may be required to file an application with the department together with other information that the department considers expedient. The license may be issued by the department.
- 24 (5) A person An individual who violates subsection (1)(d),
 25 upon a showing that the person individual was ineligible to secure
 26 a license under court order or other lawful authority, is guilty of
 27 a misdemeanor —punishable by imprisonment for not more than 180
 28 days —or a fine of not less than \$500.00 and not more than
 29 \$2,500.00, or both, and the costs of prosecution.



1 (6) An individual who violates section 43509(2) is responsible 2 for a civil infraction and may be ordered to pay a civil fine of 3 \$150.00.

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
