August 17, 2020, Introduced by Reps. Reilly, Steven Johnson, Eisen, Paquette and Lower and referred to the Committee on Government Operations.

A bill to prohibit municipalities from requiring an individual to wear a face covering on public or private property or in a public or private building; to provide for the powers and duties of certain local governmental officers and entities; and to provide that certain local ordinances, resolutions, or policies are void and unenforceable.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1. As used in this act:
- (a) "Face covering" includes, but is not limited to, a face





- mask, face shield, or respirator used to cover an individual's noseand mouth for sanitary purposes.
- 3 (b) "Governing body" means the body in which the legislative4 powers of a municipality are vested.
- 5 (c) "Municipality" means a county, city, village, or township.
- Sec. 3. Beginning on the effective date of this act, the governing body of a municipality shall not adopt or enforce an ordinance, resolution, or policy that requires an individual to wear a face covering on public or private property or in a public
- Sec. 5. Any provision in an ordinance, resolution, or policy adopted by the governing body of a municipality on or after the effective date of this act that violates section 3 is void and unenforceable.
