September 16, 2020, Introduced by Rep. Camilleri and referred to the Committee on Health Policy.

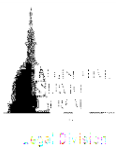
A bill to amend 1939 PA 280, entitled  
"The social welfare act,"  
(MCL 400.1 to 400.119b) by adding section 106c.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1       Sec. 106c. (1) During the time that the governor proclaims a  
2 state of emergency relating to an outbreak of COVID-19, an eligible  
3 individual includes all of the following:

4       (a) An individual 18 years of age and under who does not have  
5 health benefits coverages provided by a carrier.

6       (b) An individual over 55 years of age who does not have



1 health benefits coverages provided by a carrier.

2 (c) An immunocompromised individual who does not have health  
3 benefits coverages provided by a carrier.

4 (2) This section does not apply after January 1, 2021.

5 (3) As used in this section:

6 (a) "Carrier" means that term as defined in section 3 of the  
7 autism coverage reimbursement act, 2012 PA 101, MCL 550.1833.

8 (b) "COVID-19" means the infectious disease caused by the most  
9 recently discovered coronavirus.
