- Sec. 106c. (1) During the time that the governor proclaims a state of emergency relating to an outbreak of COVID-19, an eligible individual includes all of the following:
 - (a) An individual 18 years of age and under who does not have health benefits coverages provided by a carrier.
 - (b) An individual over 55 years of age who does not have
