


# HOUSE BILL NO. 6246

September 22, 2020, Introduced by Reps. Greig, Hope, Wittenberg, Brenda Carter and Rabhi and referred to the Committee on Government Operations.

A bill to amend 2013 PA 240, entitled  
"Michigan state capitol historic site act,"  
by amending sections 2, 4, 6, 7, 8, and 9 (MCL 4.1942, 4.1944,  
4.1946, 4.1947, 4.1948, and 4.1949); and to repeal acts and parts  
of acts.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1           Sec. 2. As used in this act:
- 2           ~~(a) "Commission" means the Michigan state capitol commission~~
- 3 ~~established in section 5.~~
- 4           (a) ~~(b)~~ "Fund" means the Michigan state capitol historic site



fund created in section 7.

(b) "Legislative council" means the legislative council provided for in section 15 of article IV of the state constitution of 1963 and created in section 103 of the legislative council act, 1986 PA 268, MCL 4.1103.

(c) "Person" means an individual, partnership, corporation, association, governmental entity, or other legal entity.

Sec. 4. (1) The Michigan state capitol historic site is established.

(2) The Michigan state capitol historic site consists of the ~~state capitol building~~ **State Capitol Building** in Lansing and the grounds of the ~~state capitol building~~ **State Capitol Building** bounded by Ottawa ~~street~~ **Street** on the north, Allegan ~~street~~ **Street** on the south, Capitol ~~avenue~~ **Avenue** on the east, and Walnut ~~street~~ **Street** on the west.

(3) Except as otherwise provided in this act, the Michigan state capitol historic site ~~shall be~~ **is** under the exclusive control of the ~~commission~~ **legislative council**.

Sec. 6. (1) The ~~commission~~ **legislative council** shall do all of the following:

(a) Subject to subsection (2), operate and manage the Michigan state capitol historic site.

(b) Maintain and restore the ~~state capitol building~~ **State Capitol Building**.

(c) Maintain and improve the grounds of the Michigan state capitol historic site.

(d) Appoint an individual to manage the day-to-day operations of the Michigan state capitol historic site. The individual appointed under this subdivision is an at-will employee and ~~shall~~



1 ~~serve~~**serves** at the pleasure of the ~~commission~~**legislative council**.

2 (e) Employ staff to carry out the ~~commission's~~  
3 responsibilities under subsection (1) and as otherwise provided by  
4 law. All individuals employed by the ~~commission~~**legislative council**  
5 **under this subdivision** are nontenured, at-will employees. The  
6 ~~commission~~**legislative council** may discipline, transfer, demote,  
7 suspend, or summarily discharge an employee.

8 (f) Contract with any person for purposes of procuring goods  
9 or services or otherwise carrying out the ~~commission's~~**legislative**  
10 **council's** responsibilities with regard to the Michigan state  
11 capitol historic site.

12 (g) Make recommendations to the governor, the senate, and the  
13 house of representatives regarding funding for the Michigan state  
14 capitol historic site, including, but not limited to, funding from  
15 the fund.

16 (h) Carry out other responsibilities as provided by law.

17 (2) The ~~commission~~**legislative council** does not have authority  
18 and shall not exercise control over the internal decisions of the  
19 senate or the house of representatives related to the allocation of  
20 space in the ~~state capitol building~~**State Capitol Building** or the  
21 ~~state capitol building~~**State Capitol Building** parking lot,  
22 including legislative or staff offices. All decisions concerning  
23 space in the ~~state capitol building~~**State Capitol Building** and the  
24 ~~state capitol building~~**State Capitol Building** parking lot ~~shall~~  
25 **must** be made according to the rules or practices of the senate and  
26 the house of representatives.

27 Sec. 7. (1) The Michigan state capitol historic site fund is  
28 created within the state treasury.

29 (2) The state treasurer may receive money or other assets from



1 any source for deposit into the fund, including private gifts,  
 2 bequests, and donations. The state treasurer shall direct the  
 3 investment of the fund. The state treasurer shall credit to the  
 4 fund interest and earnings from fund investments.

5 (3) Money in the fund at the close of the fiscal year ~~shall~~  
 6 **must** remain in the fund and ~~shall~~ not lapse to the general fund.

7 (4) The ~~commission shall be~~ **legislative council is** the  
 8 administrator of the fund for auditing purposes.

9 (5) The ~~commission~~ **legislative council** shall expend money from  
 10 the fund to carry out its responsibilities under this act.

11 Sec. 8. (1) The ~~commission~~ **legislative council** shall  
 12 establish, maintain, and operate parking facilities in the state  
 13 capitol area.

14 (2) The ~~commission~~ **legislative council** may establish and  
 15 collect a fee from state employees, state officials, and the  
 16 general public using parking facilities under the control of the  
 17 ~~commission~~ **legislative council**.

18 (3) Parking fees collected by the ~~commission~~ **legislative**  
 19 **council** pursuant to subsection (2) ~~shall~~ **must** be deposited with the  
 20 state treasurer and credited to the state capitol parking fund  
 21 created in section 9.

22 (4) In implementing this section, the ~~commission~~ **legislative**  
 23 **council** may provide for the assessment of penalties and fines, for  
 24 the removal of vehicles, and for a grievance process.

25 Sec. 9. (1) The state capitol parking fund is created within  
 26 the state treasury.

27 (2) The state treasurer may receive money or other assets from  
 28 any source for deposit into the state capitol parking fund. The  
 29 state treasurer shall direct the investment of the state capitol



1 parking fund. The state treasurer shall credit to the state capitol  
2 parking fund interest and earnings from fund investments.

3 (3) Money in the state capitol parking fund at the close of  
4 the fiscal year ~~shall~~**must** remain in the state capitol parking fund  
5 and ~~shall~~ not lapse to the general fund.

6 (4) The ~~commission shall be~~**legislative council is** the  
7 administrator of the state capitol parking fund for auditing  
8 purposes.

9 (5) The ~~commission~~**legislative council** shall expend money from  
10 the state capitol parking fund, upon appropriation, only for  
11 operations and maintenance of the ~~state capitol~~**State Capitol**  
12 **Building** parking lot.

13 Enacting section 1. Section 5 of the Michigan state capitol  
14 historic site act, 2013 PA 240, MCL 4.1945, is repealed.
