

HOUSE BILL NO. 6531

December 17, 2020, Introduced by Rep. LaGrand and referred to the Committee on Health Policy.

A bill to amend 1978 PA 368, entitled
"Public health code,"
by amending section 9208 (MCL 333.9208), as amended by 2013 PA 120.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 9208. (1) A parent, guardian, or person in loco parentis
2 applying to have a child registered for the first time in a school
3 in this state and ~~, beginning January 1, 2014,~~ a parent, guardian,
4 or person in loco parentis of a child entering ~~the seventh grade~~ ~~7~~

1 2, 5, or 7 shall present to school officials, at the time of
2 registration or not later than the first day of school, a
3 certificate of immunization or statement of exemption under section
4 9215.

5 (2) A teacher or principal shall not permit a child to enter
6 or attend school unless a certificate indicating that a minimum of
7 1 dose of an immunizing agent against each of the diseases
8 specified by the department has been received and certified to by a
9 health professional or local health department. A parent, guardian,
10 or person in loco parentis having a child registered with only
11 these minimum doses of immunizing agents shall present an updated
12 certificate of immunization within 4 months after initial
13 attendance showing that the immunizations have been completed as
14 prescribed by the department.

15 (3) The department annually shall provide a report showing a
16 year-to-year comparison of the percentage of children by age who
17 are immunized appropriately ~~upon~~**on** entering ~~the seventh grade~~ **7**.

18 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
19 after the date it is enacted into law.

20 Enacting section 2. This amendatory act does not take effect
21 unless Senate Bill No. ____ or House Bill No. 6529 (request no.
22 06723'20) of the 100th Legislature is enacted into law.
