A bill to amend 1978 PA 368, entitled "Public health code,"

(MCL 333.1101 to 333.25211) by adding sections 5116 and 9228.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 5116. If a local health officer confirms or reasonably
- 2 suspects that an individual attending school or a program of group
- 3 residence, care, or camping has a communicable disease and that

- 1 there is a risk of the spread of the communicable disease, or a
- 2 local health officer confirms or reasonably suspects that there is
- 3 a risk of the spread of a communicable disease within the community
- 4 for which a vaccine is available, the local health officer may
- 5 exclude from attendance any of the following individuals until the
- 6 local health officer determines that there is likely no further
- 7 risk of the spread of the communicable disease:
- 8 (a) An individual lacking a certificate described in section
- 9 9206 indicating that the individual has been immunized for the
- 10 communicable disease.
- 11 (b) An individual whom the local health officer otherwise
- 12 considers susceptible to the communicable disease.
- 13 Sec. 9228. The department shall inform the public of the rules
- 14 promulgated under section 9227(1)(a) to (c) through the use of mass
- 15 media and by posting the rules on the department's website.
- 16 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
- 17 after the date it is enacted into law.
