A bill to amend 1931 PA 328, entitled "The Michigan penal code,"

(MCL 750.1 to 750.568) by adding section 81f.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 81f. (1) Except as otherwise provided in this section, a person who assaults or assaults and batters a vulnerable adult and who knows the individual is a vulnerable adult is guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by imprisonment for not more than 1 year or
- 5 a fine of not more than \$1,000.00, or both.

- 1 (2) A person who commits an assault or an assault and battery
- 2 in violation of subsection (1) and who has 1 or more previous
- 3 convictions for violating subsection (1) or an ordinance of a
- 4 political subdivision of this state or of another state
- 5 substantially corresponding to subsection (1) is guilty of a felony
- 6 punishable by imprisonment for not more than 5 years or a fine of
- 7 not more than \$5,000.00, or both.
- 8 (3) This section does not apply to an individual using
- 9 necessary reasonable physical force in compliance with section 1312

- 11 (4) This section does not apply if the violation of subsection

- 15 (a) "Developmental disability" means that term as defined in

- 17 (b) "Vulnerable adult" means that term as defined in section
- 18 145m.
- 19 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
- 20 after the date it is enacted into law.
