A bill to amend 1978 PA 368, entitled "Public health code,"

by amending section 12601 (MCL 333.12601), as amended by 2009 PA 188.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 27 (v) (u) "Tobacco specialty retail store" means an
 28 establishment in which the primary purpose is the retail sale of
 29 tobacco products and smoking paraphernalia, and in which the sale

- 1 of other products is incidental. Tobacco specialty retail store
- 2 does not include a tobacco department or section of a larger
- 3 commercial establishment or any establishment with any type of
- 4 liquor, food, or restaurant license.
- 5 (w) (v) "Work area" means a site within a place of employment
- 6 at which 1 or more employees perform services for an employer.
- 7 (2) In addition, article 1 contains general definitions and
- 8 principles of construction applicable to all articles of this code.
