

SENATE BILL NO. 772

February 04, 2020, Introduced by Senators SANTANA, HOLLIER, CHANG, WOJNO, ALEXANDER, BAYER, GEISS, BULLOCK, MCMORROW and JOHNSON and referred to the Committee on Judiciary and Public Safety.

A bill to amend 2014 PA 325, entitled
"Human trafficking commission act,"
by amending section 4 (MCL 752.974).

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 4. The commission shall do all of the following subject
2 to funding:

3 (a) Identify sources for grants that will assist in examining
4 and countering human trafficking in this state, and apply for those
5 grants when appropriate.

1 (b) Fund research programs to determine the extent and nature
2 of human trafficking in this state.

3 (c) Provide information and training regarding human
4 trafficking, **including, but not limited to, recommendations for**
5 **minimum standards for training as required by law, and** to police
6 officers, prosecutors, court personnel, health care providers,
7 social services personnel, and other individuals the commission
8 considers appropriate.

9 (d) Collect and analyze information regarding human
10 trafficking in this state.

11 (e) Identify state and local agencies within this state and
12 other states, as well as within the federal government, that are
13 involved with issues relating to human trafficking, and coordinate
14 the dissemination of information regarding human trafficking in
15 this state to those agencies.

16 (f) Review the existing services available to assist victims
17 of human trafficking, including crime victim assistance, health
18 care, and legal assistance, and establish a program to make those
19 victims better aware of the services that are available to them.

20 (g) Establish a program to improve public awareness of human
21 trafficking.

22 (h) Review existing state laws and administrative rules
23 relating to human trafficking and make recommendations to the
24 legislature to improve those laws and rules to address human
25 trafficking violations in this state.

26 (i) File an annual report with the governor, the secretary of
27 the senate, and the clerk of the house of representatives regarding
28 its activities under this act. The report ~~shall~~**must** be filed not
29 later than February 1 of the year following the year for which the

1 report is due.

2 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act does not take effect
3 unless Senate Bill No. 773 of the 100th Legislature is enacted into
4 law.
