1 A resolution to commemorate the 80th anniversary of the

3 Whereas, The Michigan Fraternal Order of Police (FOP) was
4 formed in 1939 by police officers in Jackson, Grand Rapids, Ann
5 Arbor, Monroe, and Niles; and

6 Whereas, The Michigan FOP has over 10,000 members today in the
7 state. The organization has 54 lodges all over Michigan including
8 Detroit, Grand Rapids, Warren, Sterling Heights, Muskegon, Bay
9 City, Saginaw, Flint, and many more; and

10 Whereas, The Michigan FOP has held a seat on the Michigan



1 Commission on Law Enforcement Standards since MCOLES's inception in
2 1965 and also holds seats on the 911 Advisory Committee and the
3 Sheriffs Advisory Committee; and

4 Whereas, The Michigan FOP is the driving force behind the
5 Michigan Law Enforcement Officers Memorial; now, therefore, be it

6 Resolved by the House of Representatives, That the members of
7 this legislative body commemorate the 80th anniversary of the
