- 4 children whose families are in crisis and thus they play a vital
- 5 role in helping children and families heal, reconnect, and launch
- 6 children into successful adulthood; and
- 7 Whereas, Dedicated foster families frequently adopt foster
- 8 children resulting in a continual need for more foster families;

- 10 Whereas, Foster Care Awareness Month in the state of Michigan
- 11 is an appropriate opportunity to thank the families who embrace the
- 12 often thankless responsibility of providing a home and family to
- 13 children in need of affection, love, and security, and to support
- 14 the efforts of those who dedicate their time to children in and
- 15 leaving foster care; and
