SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 272

A resolution to commemorate June 11, 2020, as the celebration 1 of the 75th anniversary of the Michigan Association for Justice and 2 3 express appreciation for the organization's contributions to promoting and protecting a fair and effective justice system in 4 Michigan and safeguarding the 7th Amendment of the United States 5 Constitution. 6 Whereas, It is an honor for the members of the Michigan 8 Legislature to join in saluting the Michigan Association for Justice (MAJ) as it marks 75 years of service in jurisprudence. 9 10 This renowned group was formed in 1945 with approximately twenty 11 lawyers who were specialists in workers' compensation. Mr. Sam 12 Charfoos served as the first president of the organization which is

dedicated to ensuring access to the civil justice system and 1 defending our cherished right to a civil trial by jury; and 2 Whereas, The 7th Amendment to the United States Constitution 3 grants every American the right to a civil trial by jury. Over the 4 5 years, members of MAJ have fought courageously to protect the 6 rights of consumers, workers, children, and families from powerful 7 forces aligned against them. Trial lawyers are champions for 8 vulnerable people who would otherwise have no voice; and 9 Whereas, The Constitution of Michigan of 1963, Article 1, 10 Section 14, states that "The right of [civil] trial by jury shall 11 remain." We applaud the efforts of MAJ members to keep the justice system fair and open. Through effective efforts on behalf of 12 innocent victims, civil rights, and equal rights, many people have 13 14 gained access to justice, and many others have been protected by 15 the precedents that certain of these cases have set. The 16 accomplishments of the Michigan Association for Justice in 17 fulfilling its mission of promoting and protecting a fair and 18 effective justice system and ensuring that any person who is 19 injured by the misconduct or negligence of others can obtain 20 justice in Michigan's courtrooms stand as a bulwark against unfairness, inequity, and injustice. Its 75 years of vigilance and 21 attainment gives great significance to this notable milestone in 22 23 MAJ history; now, therefore, be it 24 Resolved by the House of Representatives, that the members of 25 this legislative body commemorate June 11, 2020, as the celebration of the 75th anniversary of the Michigan Association for Justice and 26 27 express appreciation for the organization's contributions to promoting and protecting a fair and effective justice system in 28 29 Michigan and safeguarding the 7th amendment of the United States
