

HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 366

The Speaker, on behalf of the entire membership, offered the following resolution:

1 A resolution of tribute for the Honorable Triston Cole.

2 Whereas, It is with great appreciation that we thank and honor
3 Representative Triston Cole as he completes his service with the
4 House of Representatives. Representative Cole served the people of
5 this state, especially his constituents in the One Hundred-Fifth
6 District, containing Antrim, Otsego, Charlevoix, Montmorency, and
7 Oscoda counties, with the utmost integrity; and

8 Whereas, Representative Cole brought a wealth of experience
9 from the agricultural, trucking, and hunting industries. He
10 attended Northwestern Michigan College and Ferris State University.
11 He and his wife own a family farm, which provides produce to local
12 markets, and when he wasn't working on the farm, he was a semi-

1 truck driver and taught agriculture. Prior to his election to the
2 House of Representatives, he served as president of the Antrim
3 County Farm Bureau and chair of the Antrim County Republican Party;

5 Whereas, Representative Cole has been an asset to the House of
6 Representatives since he was first elected in 2014. His leadership
7 was displayed when he served as chair of the Committee on
8 Transportation and Infrastructure and vice chair of the committees
9 on Agriculture and Government Operations. During the 2019-2020
10 session, he served as Majority Floor Leader and was a member of the
11 House Fiscal Agency Governing Committee. He was also a valuable
12 member of the committees on Energy Policy, Tourism and Outdoor
13 Recreation, Judiciary, and Michigan Competitiveness. He worked to
14 reform auto insurance, expand broadband services in rural
15 communities, and simplify the permitting processes for vehicles;
16 now, therefore, be it

18 expression of tribute to commend and thank the Honorable Triston
19 Cole for his notable contributions to this legislative body and to
20 our state; and be it further
