- A resolution to recognize the 46th anniversary of the issuance
- ${f 2}$ of the U.S. Supreme Court Roe v. Wade ruling.
- 3 Whereas, The Michigan House of Representatives recognizes the
- 4 anniversary of the United States Supreme Court decision, Roe v.
- 5 Wade, decided on January 22, 1973, affirming that the United States
- 6 Constitution safeguards a woman's right to make her own medical
- 7 decisions, and that government should not intrude in the most
- 8 private and personal family matters; and
- 9 Whereas, Women's reproductive freedom is vital to a woman's
- 10 health, economic security, and the ability to participate equally

- 1 in society. Comprehensive reproductive health care, including safe
- 2 abortion, is a vital component of a woman's overall health; and
- 3 Whereas, Like other medical procedures, the safety of abortion
- 4 is furthered by evidence-based practices developed and supported by
- 5 medical professionals. Any regulation of medical care should have a
- 6 legitimate purpose and if possible, be enforced in a way that
- 7 increases, rather than decreases, access; and
- 8 Whereas, In the landmark decision Whole Woman's Health v.
- 9 Hellerstedt, the Supreme Court recently reaffirmed a woman's
- 10 constitutional right to access safe, legal abortion, confirming
- 11 more than 40 years of precedent; and
- 12 Whereas, One in three women will need an abortion in her
- 13 lifetime. Safe, legal, and accessible abortion is an essential
- 14 component of comprehensive reproductive health care. Abortion is
- 15 one of the safest medical procedures performed in the United States
- 16 with more than a 99 percent safety record; and
- 17 Whereas, Everyone should have access to comprehensive health
- 18 care in the state of Michigan. A woman's right to access safe,
- 19 legal abortion without burdensome restrictions imposed by a state
- 20 is at stake; now, therefore, be it
- 21 Resolved by the House of Representatives, That the members of
- 22 this legislative body recognize the 46th anniversary of the
- 23 issuance of the U.S. Supreme Court Roe v. Wade ruling; and be it
- 24 further
- 25 Resolved, That we denounce violence towards abortion providers
- 26 and their patients and oppose efforts to undermine the Roe v. Wade
- 27 Supreme Court decision by eliminating access to abortion in
- 28 Michigan and throughout the country; and be it further
- 29 Resolved, That we affirm that all people have the right to

- 1 access reproductive healthcare services without fear of violence,
- 2 intimidation, or harassment and; and be it further
- 3 Resolved, That we support the right to access health care
- 4 without interference in this state, including safe and legal
- 5 abortion.
