## HOUSE RESOLUTION NO.68

Rep. Hope offered the following resolution:

- 1 A resolution to declare April 16, 2019, as Healthcare
- 2 Decisions Day in the state of Michigan.
- 3 Whereas, National Healthcare Decisions Day is April 16, 2019,
- 4 and is designed to raise public awareness of the need to plan ahead
- 5 for health care decisions related to end of life care and medical
- 6 decision-making whenever patients are unable to speak for
- 7 themselves and to encourage the specific use of advance directives
- 8 to communicate these important health care decisions; and
- **9** Whereas, It is estimated that only about 20 percent of people
- 10 in Michigan have executed an advance directive, in part due to a
- 11 lack of knowledge about advance directives and considerable public
- 12 confusion arising from advance directives that are often written in
- 13 difficult to understand legal and medical terms; and

Whereas, Easy-to-understand advance directives that are 1 2 written in plain language, such as Five Wishes and Elder Law of Michigan, distributed by the non-profit organization Aging with 3 4 Dignity, are desirable because they enable completion and foster 5 important family discussions; and Whereas, Because Five Wishes is available in 29 languages and 6 in Braille, citizens of our ethnic and culturally diverse state 7 can, like English speakers, state their wishes about comfort, 8 9 dignity, and the personal, family, and spiritual issues that matter 10 most; and 11 Whereas, Michigan citizens can complete an advanced directive and submit it to the statewide registry called Peace of Mind; and 12 13 Whereas, One of the principal goals of Healthcare Decisions Day is to encourage hospitals, nursing homes, assisted living 14 facilities, continuing care retirement communities, and hospices to 15 16 participate in a statewide effort to provide clear and consistent information to the public about advance directives and increase the 17 18 number of Michigan residents with advance directives; and 19 Whereas, Many of the Michigan health care, business, faith-20 based groups, and senior services organizations have demonstrated 21 commendable leadership in furthering patient and caregiver-focused 22 advance care planning, and are committed to educating the public about the importance of discussing health care choices and 23 24 completing advance directives; and 25 Whereas, As a result of April 16, 2019, being recognized as 26 Healthcare Decisions Day throughout Michigan, more citizens will 27 have conversations about their health care decisions, more citizens 28 will execute advance directives to make their wishes known, and

fewer families and health care providers will have to struggle with

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- 1 making difficult health care decisions in the absence of guidance
- 2 from the patient; now, therefore, be it
- 3 Resolved by the House of Representatives, That the members of
- 4 this legislative body declare April 16, 2019, as Healthcare
- 5 Decisions Day in the state of Michigan. We call this observance to
- 6 the attention of all our citizens.
