

# HOUSE RESOLUTION NO.312

Rep. Glenn offered the following resolution:

1       A resolution to declare September 17-23, 2020, as Constitution  
2 Week in the state of Michigan.

3       Whereas, September 17, 2020, marks the two hundred and thirty-  
4 third anniversary of the drafting of the Constitution of the United  
5 States of America by the Constitutional Convention; and

6       Whereas, The 233rd anniversary of the signing of the  
7 Constitution provides an historic opportunity for citizens  
8 throughout Michigan and the nation to pay tribute to our Founding  
9 Fathers and to reflect on the rights, privileges, and  
10 responsibilities of citizenship; and

11       Whereas, By instilling faith in the promise of democracy, the  
12 United States Constitution has served as a model for democratic  
13 governments around the globe; and



1       Whereas, The United States Constitution secured our commitment  
2 to freedom and democracy, a commitment which has guided us through  
3 more than two centuries of enormous growth and change; and

4       Whereas, We encourage all citizens to study the Constitution  
5 and reflect on the privilege of being an American with all the  
6 rights and responsibilities which that privilege involves; and

7       Whereas, The Constitution of the United States of America, the  
8 guardian of our liberties, embodies the principles of limited  
9 government in a republic dedicated to rule by law; and

10       Whereas, Constitution Week is a time to emphasize citizens'  
11 responsibilities for protecting and defending the Constitution;  
12 now, therefore, be it

13       Resolved by the House of Representatives, That the members of  
14 this legislative body declare September 17-23, 2020, as  
15 Constitution Week in the state of Michigan.
