SENATE RESOLUTION NO.77

Senator Shirkey offered the following resolution:

1 A resolution of tribute offered as a memorial for Gary G.

Corbin, former member of the Senate.

3 Whereas, It is with great sadness that the members of this

4 legislative body learned of the passing of Gary Corbin. He was an

5 outstanding public servant who was deeply committed to improving

6 the lives of his constituents in Genesee County and the people of

the entire state during his twelve years in the Senate; and

8 Whereas, Gary Corbin was a native of the Hoosier state,

9 attending college at Anderson University where he was a standout

10 football player, but he made Michigan his home. He put down roots

11 in Clio where he served as a pastor and raised two daughters with

12 his wife, Sheila. He entered public service as a member of the

13 Genesee County Board of Commissioners from 1971-1974 and was

- 1 elected to the Senate for the first time in 1974; and
- 2 Whereas, In the Senate, Gary Corbin quickly made a name for
- 3 himself as someone who could work with people with different views
- 4 and backgrounds. His colleagues appreciated the decency and empathy
- 5 with which he approached his work in the Legislature, entrusting
- 6 him with a variety of leadership positions during his tenure,
- 7 including assistant majority leader, majority floor leader, and
- 8 minority floor leader. Labor, taxation, and education were among
- 9 the issues he worked most closely on, chairing the Colleges and
- 10 Universities Committee and Finance Committee and sponsoring more
- 11 than 75 public acts across his three terms; and
- 12 Whereas, Gary Corbin ended his service in the Legislature in
- 13 1986, but his work serving the public continued for many years
- 14 after. He was the chief deputy director of the Department of Labor,
- 15 served on the State Officers Compensation Commission, and was
- 16 elected chairman of the Michigan Democratic Party before moving
- 17 into the private sector. In 1996, he started an insurance agency
- 18 with one of his daughters that grew to have a presence in more than
- 19 two dozen states; and
- 20 Whereas, Gary Corbin saw public service as a calling,
- 21 committing himself to the improvement of the lives of the people of
- 22 Michigan. Upon his passing, we offer our condolences to his family
- 23 and friends. We hope that they may find comfort in the knowledge
- 24 that the community as a whole shares in their bereavement and that
- 25 the legacy of Gary Corbin's contributions will long continue to
- 26 enrich our state; now, therefore, be it
- 27 Resolved by the Senate, That we offer this expression of our
- 28 highest tribute to honor the memory of Gary G. Corbin, a member of
- 29 the Senate from 1975 to 1986; and be it further

- 1 Resolved, That copies of this resolution be transmitted to the
- 2 Corbin family as evidence of our lasting esteem for his memory.
