## SENATE RESOLUTION NO.136

Senator Santana offered the following resolution:

A resolution to urge the Governor to ban the display of the
Confederate flag from all state properties.

Whereas, The Confederate flag is a symbol of immense hatred which seeks to celebrate the most disgraceful aspects of our nation's history. The flag was first used as a banner and emblem for those who fought to maintain a system where humans were owned by other humans — a system of slavery. In the year's after the Civil War, the flag was — and continues to be — used to intimidate,

9 harass, and terrorize black people and their communities; and10 Whereas, Displaying a Confederate flag is a direct affront to

the one in seven Michiganders who are of African descent and has no place on state property. The Confederate flag is a symbol of white

13 supremacy that dishonors the memory of the brave Michiganders who

- 1 fought and died to end slavery and who have continued to make
- 2 sacrifices for civil rights in the century and a half since; and
- 3 Whereas, There is no law prohibiting the display of the
- 4 Confederate flag on state property. The Governor, through the
- 5 executive power vested in her by the state constitution, should
- 6 make clear that this symbol of hatred and oppression has no place
- 7 in this state by directing that no properties under the control of
- 8 the state of Michigan may display the Confederate flag; now,
- 9 therefore, be it
- 10 Resolved by the Senate, That we urge the Governor to ban the
- 11 display of the Confederate flag on state properties, including the
- 12 state Capitol; and be it further
- 13 Resolved, That copies of this resolution be transmitted to the
- **14** Governor.
