## **SUMMARY:**

Senate Bill 398 would amend the Michigan Gaming Control and Revenue Act to allow casinos to televise simulcast horse races on casino premises, or allow them to be televised, if the casino license holder also holds a third-party facilitator license issued under the Horse Racing Law.

The bill is tie-barred to Senate Bill 396, which means that it could not take effect unless Senate Bill 396 were also enacted.
