## **SUMMARY:**

House Bill 5999 would amend the Insurance Code to require the Department of Insurance and Financial Services (DIFS) to annually prepare and post on its website a report containing information on all of the following (which pertain to no-fault auto insurance personal injury protection benefits) for the preceding calendar year:

- Complaints related to payment or reimbursement for treatment or rehabilitative occupational training under section 3157 of the code.
- Complaints related to payment or reimbursement for attendant care under section 3157.
- Complaints related to utilization reviews under section 3157a.

DIFS would have to include in the report all of the following for each category described above:

- The number of patients included in each complaint.
- The final disposition of each complaint.
- The number of complaints for each auto insurer.

## **FISCAL IMPACT:**

House Bill 5999 would not have a significant fiscal impact on any state or local government units. The Department of Insurance and Financial Services may incur modest costs for the reporting required under the bill, but the costs would likely be sufficiently absorbed by existing department appropriations and resources.
