SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 4251

A bill to prohibit the sale of vapor products that contain vitamin E acetate; and to prescribe penalties.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 3. As used in this act:
- (a) "Liquid nicotine" means a liquid containing nicotine in
 any concentration that is sold, marketed, or intended for use in a
 vapor product.
- 5 (b) "Vapor product" means a noncombustible product that
- 6 employs a heating element, power source, electronic circuit, or
- 7 other electronic, chemical, or mechanical means, regardless of
- 8 shape or size, that can be used to produce vapor from liquid
- 9 nicotine, and the use or inhalation of which simulates smoking.
- 10 Vapor product includes an electronic cigarette, electronic cigar,

- 1 electronic cigarillo, electronic pipe, or similar product or device
- 2 and a vapor cartridge or other container of liquid nicotine in a
- 3 solution or other form that is intended to be used with or in an
- 4 electronic cigarette, electronic cigar, electronic cigarillo,
- 5 electronic pipe, or similar product or device. Vapor product does
- 6 not include a product regulated as a drug or device by the United
- 7 States Food and Drug Administration under 21 USC 351 to 360fff-7.
- 8 Sec. 5. (1) A person shall not sell a vapor product that
- 9 contains or has been combined with any of the following:
- 10 (a) Vitamin E acetate.
- 11 (b) Any other ingredient that the United States Food and Drug
- 12 Administration has, at the concentration present within the liquid
- 13 nicotine, prohibited for inhalation.
- 14 (2) A person that violates subsection (1) is guilty of a
- 15 misdemeanor punishable by a fine of not more than \$10,000.00.
