HOUSE BILL NO. 4899

May 25, 2021, Introduced by Reps. Filler and Bolden and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

A bill to amend 1949 PA 300, entitled "Michigan vehicle code,"

by amending section 236 (MCL 257.236), as amended by 2000 PA 64.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 236. (1) If ownership of a vehicle passes by operation of
- 2 law, upon furnishing satisfactory proof of that ownership to the
- 3 secretary of state, the person acquiring the vehicle may procure a
- 4 title to the vehicle regardless of whether a certificate of title
- 5 has ever been issued. Upon death of an owner of a registered

- 1 vehicle, the license plate assigned to the vehicle, unless the
- 2 vehicle is destroyed, is a valid registration until the end of the
- 3 registration year or until the personal representative of the
- 4 owner's estate transfers ownership of the vehicle.
- 5 (2) If—Subject to subsection (3), if an owner of 1 or more
- 6 vehicles , which vehicles do not that have a total value of not
- 7 more than \$60,000.00, \$100,000.00 dies and the owner does not leave
- 8 other property that requires the issuance of letters as provided in
- 9 under section 3103 of the estates and protected individuals code,
- 10 1998 PA 386, MCL 700.3103, the owner's surviving spouse, or an heir
- 11 of the owner in the order specified in section 2103 of the estates
- 12 and protected individuals code, 1998 PA 386, MCL 700.2103, may
- 13 apply for a title, after furnishing providing the secretary of
- 14 state with proper proof of the death of the registered owner,
- 15 attaching to the proof a certification setting forth the fact that
- 16 the applicant is the surviving spouse or an heir. Upon proper
- 17 petition, the secretary of state shall furnish provide the
- 18 applicant with a certificate of title.
- 19 (3) Beginning January 1, 2023 and each January 1 thereafter,
- 20 the \$100,000.00 total value amount in subsection (2) must be
- 21 multiplied by the cost-of-living adjustment factor. Beginning
- 22 December 1, 2022 and each December 1 thereafter, the secretary of
- 23 state shall determine the adjusted total value amount for the
- 24 following year.
- 25 (4) As used in this section:
- 26 (a) "Cost-of-living adjustment factor" means a fraction in
- 27 which the numerator is the United States Consumer Price Index for
- 28 the prior calendar year and the denominator is the United States
- 29 Consumer Price Index for the 2021 calendar year.

- 1 (b) "United States Consumer Price Index" means the annual
 2 average of the United States Consumer Price Index for all urban
 3 consumers as defined and reported by the United States Department
 4 of Labor, Bureau of Labor Statistics, and as certified by the state
 5 treasurer.
- 6 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days 7 after the date it is enacted into law.
