## **HOUSE BILL NO. 6184**

A bill to amend 1978 PA 368, entitled "Public health code,"

by amending section 2253 (MCL 333.2253), as amended by 2006 PA 157, and by adding section 2253a.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 2253. (1) If Subject to section 2253a, if the director
- 2 determines that control of an epidemic is necessary to protect the
- 3 public health, the director by emergency order may prohibit the

- 1 gathering of people persons for any purpose and may establish
- 2 procedures to be followed during the epidemic to insure ensure
- 3 continuation of essential public health services and enforcement of
- 4 health laws. Emergency procedures shall—are not be—limited to this
- 5 code. An emergency order issued under this subsection must identify
- 6 the epidemic that is the subject of the emergency order and include
- 7 both of the following:
- 8 (a) A description of how any prohibition on the gathering of
- 9 persons or procedures to be followed in the emergency order
- 10 protects the public health.
- 11 (b) All information that the director used when making the
- 12 determination to issue the emergency order, including, but not
- 13 limited to, data or statistics used by the director in determining
- 14 that the control of the epidemic through emergency order is
- 15 necessary to protect the public health.
- 16 (2) If an epidemic described in subsection (1) involves avian
- 17 influenza or another virus or disease that is or may be spread by
- 18 contact with animals, the department of agriculture and rural
- 19 development shall cooperate with and assist the director in the
- 20 director's response to the epidemic.
- 21 (3) Upon On request from the director, the department of
- 22 agriculture and rural development shall assist the department in
- 23 any review or update of the department's pandemic influenza plan
- 24 under section 5112.
- 25 Sec. 2253a. Beginning November 15, 2020, an emergency order
- 26 issued under section 2253 is valid for the time period specified in
- 27 the order or until the order has been in effect for 28 days,
- 28 whichever is sooner. After 28 days, both of the following apply:
- 29 (a) The director shall rescind the emergency order unless a

- 1 request from the director to extend the emergency order for a
- 2 specific number of days is approved by resolution of both houses of
- 3 the legislature.
- 4 (b) The director shall not issue a new emergency order based
- 5 on the same epidemic for which the emergency order was issued under
- 6 section 2253 unless the order is approved by resolution of both
- 7 houses of the legislature.
- 8 Enacting section 1. Section 2253a as added by this amendatory
- 9 act is intended to be retroactive and applies to emergency orders
- 10 issued under section 2253 of the public health code, 1978 PA 368,
- 11 MCL 333.2253, on or after November 15, 2020.
