## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 85. (1) Infected and uninhabitable dwellings to be
vacated. Whenever it shall be certified by an inspector or officer
of the health department that a dwelling is infected with
contagious disease or that it is unfit for human habitation, or
dangerous to life or health by reason of want of repair, or of
defects in the drainage, plumbing, lighting, ventilation, or the

- (d) There are defects in the drainage, plumbing, lighting,ventilation, or construction of the dwelling.
